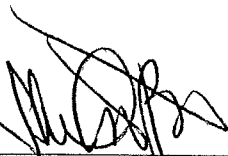

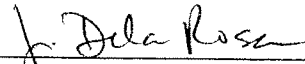

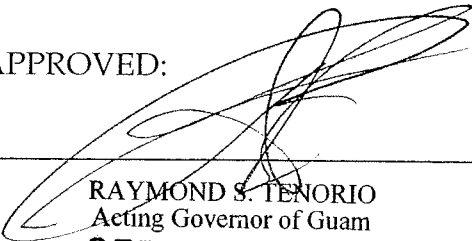

**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW §3112.2 TO ARTICLE 1,
CHAPTER 3, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,

PROGRAM: SCHOOL CRIME STOPPERS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
there is a need to address the continual rash of crimes that have victimized our
students and our community for years, and that there is a need to implement
measures so students, faculty, staff, administrators, and the entire community can

1 take ownership of the protection of our island schools and put a stop to these
2 senseless acts so that school communities can continuously function with a sense
3 of security and safety.

4 *I Liheslatura* further finds that Guam Crime Stoppers, Inc., has been an
5 effective tool in the reporting and apprehension of individuals suspected of having
6 committed crimes against the community. There is another program component
7 that has been effective in reducing crimes in schools throughout international
8 jurisdictions: Crime Stoppers for schools. According to Crime Stoppers USA, the
9 first student Crime Stoppers program was started in a Boulder, Colorado high
10 school in 1983. Now, over two thousand (2,000) programs exist in middle and
11 high schools, community colleges and colleges throughout the nation. The Crime
12 Stoppers Program provides a mechanism for the anonymous reporting of crimes,
13 so that individuals will *not* have to fear reprisal. While there is a monetary
14 incentive to report the crimes, a School Crime Stoppers Program in Hawaii states
15 that students are not driven to report crimes for the reward, rather they are
16 motivated because of “school spirit, pride, and responsibility.”

17 *I Liheslatura* further finds that, through communication with stakeholders,
18 there is a willingness and support for the implementation of a Crime Stoppers
19 program for Guam Department of Education schools. *I Liheslatura*, therefore,
20 intends to provide the education department with an additional method to help curb
21 and prevent crimes from occurring in our schools and communities that may be
22 implemented at minimal costs driven by the community’s need to stop crimes in
23 our schools and against the community.

24 It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslatura* to create a bridge between the
25 Guam Department of Education and the entities Guam Crime Stoppers, Inc., and
26 the Guam Police Department to ensure the Program’s effectiveness.

1 **Section 2.** A new §3112.2 is *added* to Article 1, Chapter 3 of Title 17,
2 Guam Code Annotated, to read:

3 **“§ 3112.2. Safe Schools Program: School Crime Stoppers.**

4 The Guam Education Board (Board) *shall* adopt a policy to address
5 crimes being committed within the Guam Department of Education (GDOE)
6 schools. The Board *shall* implement crime-prevention efforts found
7 successful in other jurisdictions and implement such policies.

8 The policy *shall* include, but is *not* limited to, the following:

9 (a) **School Safety Coordinator.** Each school *shall* identify
10 a School Safety Coordinator (an administrator or school counselor)
11 who will be responsible for overseeing the Program for individual
12 GDOE schools.

13 (b) **School Crime Stoppers Coordinator.** The Guam
14 Police Department Chief of Police will assign an employee of the
15 Guam Police Department to serve as the School Crime Stoppers
16 Coordinator to work with GDOE School Safety Coordinators, and to
17 serve as liaison to Guam Crime Stoppers, Inc. and the Guam Police
18 Department.

19 (1) The School Crime Stoppers Coordinator will be
20 responsible for organizing awareness and education events for
21 students, and the broader community, with the Guam Police
22 Department, the Guam Crime Stoppers, the Office of the
23 Attorney General, the Mayors Council of Guam, and other
24 relative agencies and organizations, as well as training events
25 for administrators, faculty, staff, school parent organizations
26 and families.

1 (2) Partnership with Guam Crime Stoppers, Inc. The
2 Board *shall* explore options of developing a partnership with
3 Guam Crime Stoppers, Inc. to identify the School Crime
4 Stoppers Program needs, such as securing phone services, the
5 possible implementation of procedures for online web tips for
6 the reporting of crimes that occur on GDOE campuses, and
7 other related needs.

8 (3) The School Crime Stoppers Coordinator will
9 forward reports of tips and calls that have led to arrests for
10 crimes to the Guam Crime Stoppers Board of Directors for
11 disposition, in accordance with the organization's current
12 procedures. For infractions or instances where the event is *not*
13 a criminal activity, the School Safety Coordinator and the
14 School Crime Stopper Coordinator will determine, *or* make a
15 referral for, the appropriate disciplinary action, *or* make a
16 referral to the appropriate entity.

17 (4) The School Crime Stoppers Coordinator and the
18 School Safety Coordinators *shall* coordinate with the Guam
19 Crime Stoppers, Inc., and make recommendations for policy
20 relative to fundraising efforts to support the School Crime
21 Stoppers program. Said recommendations *shall* be presented to
22 the GDOE Board and Superintendent of Education for
23 consideration and subsequent development of policy.

24 (c) **Data Collection.** The Guam Department of Education School
25 Safety Coordinators and School Crime Stoppers Coordinator will work in
26 tandem to collect statistical data generated from call-ins or web tips of
27 crimes or violations.

1 (1) Statistical data may be used to obtain grants intent on
2 increasing student involvement and achievement, and the promotion
3 of safe, crime-free schools and communities.

4 (2) The data *shall* be published quarterly for public review
5 on the Guam Department of Education website.

6 (d) Both the School Safety Coordinators and the School Crime
7 Stopper Coordinator will be responsible for determining what appropriate
8 disciplinary action will be taken or referrals will be made to appropriate
9 authorities if what is reported is *not* a crime. If what is reported, however, is
10 a crime, the coordinators shall forward it to the appropriate authorities for
11 disposition.

12 (e) **Implementation.** The Program *shall* be implemented in all
13 Guam Department of Education schools.”

14 **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provision of this law or its application to
15 any person *or* circumstance is found to be invalid *or* contrary to law, such
16 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this law which can be
17 given effect.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Subsection § 3106.1 is hereby *added* to Article 1, Chapter 3 of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated to read:

"§ 3106.1 Caffeinated Malt Beverage. A caffeinated malt beverage is a beverage containing at least .5% alcohol by volume, which is either:

(a) Produced by a brewer as defined in 26 U.S.C. § 5092 and to which is added, or infused with, caffeine and/or other stimulants including, but not limited to, guarana, ginseng, absinthe, and taurine;

OR

(b) Treated by processing, filtration, or another method of manufacture that is not generally recognized as a traditional process in the production of a beer as described in C.F.R. Sec. 25.55 and to which is added a flavor or other ingredient containing alcohol, except for a hop extract and caffeine and/or other stimulants including, but not limited to, guarana, ginseng, absinthe, and taurine; and for which the producer is required to file a formula for approval with the United States

1 Alcohol and Tobacco Trade and Tax Bureau pursuant to 27 C.F.R.
2 Sec. 25.55 OR that is not exempt under Subdivision (f) of 27 C.F.R.
3 Sec. 25.55.”

4 **Section 2.** A new Subsection §3702.1 is hereby *added* to Article 7,
5 Chapter 3 of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated to read:

6 “§ 3702.1 **Sale of Caffeinated Malt Beverages.** No Caffeinated Malt
7 Beverages may be imported, produced, manufactured, distributed, or
8 sold at any retail outlet in Guam.”

9 **Section 3. Effective Date.** The effective date of this statute shall be
10 one month from the date of its enactment.”

Senator Cruz – Sponsor Statement

As the main sponsor of Bill No. 178-31 (LS), I apologize for my absence.

However, I am grateful that my cosponsor, Senator Palacios, is reading this sponsor statement today. Bill No. 178-31 (LS) is important legislation to prohibit the importation, production, distribution or sale of malt beverages infused with caffeine and/or stimulants such as guarana, ginseng, absinthe, and taurine.

Data from the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System reveals that both heavy drinking and binge drinking are significantly higher among adults on Guam as compared to the US. Heavy drinking among Guam males is almost double that of US males (10.7% vs. 5.6%), while binge drinking among Guam males is 65% higher (34.5% vs. 20.9%). About 25% of heavy drinkers and 20% of binge drinkers are aged 18-24. Half of all heavy drinkers and 40% of binge drinkers are under the age of 35. Malt beverages infused with caffeine and other stimulants are a highly intoxicating supersized alcoholic beverage marketed largely to young consumers through a colorful array of 23.5- ounce single serving cans in assorted flavors including grape, strawberry lemonade, strawberry watermelon, and blueberry pomegranate. Each 23.5-ounce can contains nearly the equivalent of five servings of alcohol. If consumed in an hour, one can meet the standard for binge drinking.

The combination of caffeine and other stimulants does not ameliorate alcohol's negative effects on motor coordination. Adding caffeine and other stimulants is potentially harmful because such additives impair one's ability to judge their intoxication level. Young people are particularly vulnerable because they are more likely to misjudge their intoxication level and are more likely to take risks. BLAST, and other brands such as Four Loko, Joose, and Tilt, are examples of powerful and dangerous sickly sweet alcohol in a can. High consumption of these brands may lead our youth to drive intoxicated, commit sexual assault, suicide, and perform poorly in school. With Bill No. 178-31 (LS), it is my hope that my colleagues will join Senator Palacios and I in banning beverages of these types before they gain a negative stranglehold on Guam's youthful consumer.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Subsection § 3106.1 is hereby *added* to Article 1, Chapter 3 of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated to read:

"§ 3106.1 Caffeinated Malt Beverage. A caffeinated malt beverage is a beverage containing at least .5% alcohol by volume, which is either:

(a) Produced by a brewer as defined in 26 U.S.C. § 5092 and to which is added, or infused with, caffeine and/or other stimulants including, but not limited to, guarana, ginseng, absinthe, and taurine;

OR

(b) Treated by processing, filtration, or another method of manufacture that is not generally recognized as a traditional process in the production of a beer as described in C.F.R. Sec. 25.55 and to which is added a flavor or other ingredient containing alcohol, except for a hop extract and caffeine and/or other stimulants including, but not limited to, guarana, ginseng, absinthe, and taurine; and for which the producer is required to file a formula for approval with the United States

1 Alcohol and Tobacco Trade and Tax Bureau pursuant to 27 C.F.R.
2 Sec. 25.55 OR that is not exempt under Subdivision (f) of 27 C.F.R.
3 Sec. 25.55.”

4 **Section 2.** A new Subsection §3702.1 is hereby *added* to Article 7,
5 Chapter 3 of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated to read:

6 **“§ 3702.1 Sale of Caffeinated Malt Beverages.** No Caffeinated Malt
7 Beverages may be imported, produced, manufactured, distributed, or
8 sold at any retail outlet in Guam.”

9 **Section 3. Effective Date.** The effective date of this statute shall be
10 one month from the date of its enactment.”
