II. COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS

(a) Bill Sponsor Summary

Senator Guthertz: Good morning ladies and gentlemen, mayors, and agencies from the different government. This bill is really simple; it authorizes the Mayors' Council to carry over their funding from last fiscal year to this fiscal year. It's an incentive for the mayors to carefully utilize the funds they have to program monies for projects that are needed. By losing the monies they have been saving for projects is really penalizing the mayors rather than supporting them. I would like to see the legislature allow the mayors to always carry over the monies they save. Also madam chair we are not talking a lot of money here but whatever is available is sorely needed in the villages.

Senator Barnes: Thanks you Senator Guthertz

(b) Testimony

1. Mayor Jose Terlaje, Yona Mayor

Mayor Terlaje: I would like to thank the committee for giving us this opportunity to come today and testify on Bill 510. Being the chairman for the legislative committee with the Mayors' Council I am also in charge of the finance. I did approach the senator to initiate a bill to carry over from our previous budget. The reason why I do this every year is because this really works for the Mayors' Council. If we don't do this we recklessly spend the money because we lose it. Another thing is our funding comes out late. We start our budget in October but sometimes it's not downloaded until two three months after. If we are talking about a project over fifteen thousand under the procurement requirement sometimes we can't even get started until four months later and by the time we commence the project the budget is close to being cleared out. Although I'm stepping down in January I would like to ask the members to continue supporting the mayors. We all know most of the work we do is overwhelming. My village for example collects three to four trailers of trash a day and after the first trailer we are charged one hundred and seventy dollars. That is something we can't afford or is in our budget. Most of the money comes from out of our pockets. When I became a mayor in 2001 I was short on cash all the time because I used my own money. With that I thank you for hearing us today. Thank you.

Senator Cruz: Thank you mayor that is an excellent idea and fiscally responsible. Mayor Sablan.

2. Mr. Angel Sablan, Executive Director Mayors' Council of Guam

Mr. Sablan: Thanks you Senator Cruz, Guthertz, Barnes, and Ada. This bill is something the Mayors' council uses every budget year. As a matter of fact this is the first time it wasn't included into the budget but we appreciated Senator Guthertz and Barnes for coming forward. This is a tool that we mayors use because we have no capital outlay money or no big money for big projects. So, mayors purposely save their money to add it on to their next budget year. I can tell you last year the carry over allowed us to get trailers and vehicles for the different mayors.

Right now if you see Nito Blas he is driving around in his 1926 Ford pick-up that came from GSA. The other day he got pulled over and he came in and said Mr. Sablan what am I going to do, they pulled me over because my truck has no hood. It was true it had no hood and he told the police officer "Sir my mechanic told me that my car is overheating and I might as well take off the hood, which he did. What I'm saying is our mayors use anything just to get by. If you go to some mayors offices the only thing holding up those offices is the termites. With this carry over we will use the monies to fix some of those problems. We thank Senator Guthertz and Speaker Won Pat for being a co-sponsor. We would like to thank everyone and we assure you this money will be used wisely.

3. Mayor Ben Gumataotao, Piti Mayor

Mayor Gumataotao: Good morning, thank you for having me here. My name is Ben Gumataotao, Piti Mayor. Thank you Senator Guthertz for introducing this bill, you're helping out the community not the mayors. We need this money to buy more expensive equipment and we cannot afford it during budget time. So we need to save it, it's like putting money in a bank. I want to thank you for that.




