

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §1033 OF CHAPTER 10, TITLE 1,

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds  
3 that since 2006, the Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race, an event intended to raise awareness  
4 for Guam's endangered official Territorial Bird and to attract international athletes

1 to Guam, has become an annual addition to the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair. As  
2 the Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race has become an integral part of the Guam-Micronesia  
3 Island Fair, it is appropriate that the event be an official function of the government  
4 of Guam, and that the two (2) events be joined and renamed to the Guam-  
5 Micronesia Island Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*  
6 further finds that public safety support from the Guam Police Department and  
7 Guam Fire Department for the events is warranted.

8 **Section 2.** §1033 of Chapter 10, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby  
9 *amended* to read:

10 **“§ 1033. Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'***  
11 **Road Race.**

12 (a) Annually, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan* (Governor) *shall* issue a  
13 proclamation calling upon the people of Guam to observe a Guam-  
14 Micronesia Island Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race, which *shall* be held at  
15 the discretion of the Guam Visitors Bureau.

16 (b) The Guam Visitors Bureau *shall* be the organizing body for the  
17 Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race, and *shall*  
18 provide the necessary logistics and financial support to ensure the success of  
19 the Fair as an international event and visitor attraction. The Department of  
20 Parks and Recreation *shall* assist by issuing permits for booths and exhibits,  
21 and designing the general layout of booths, exhibits and activities, with  
22 cultural awareness paramount in the design. The Department of Public  
23 Works *shall* inspect and ensure that the public facilities at the selected site  
24 are in good working condition to adequately protect the health and safety of  
25 the persons at the Fair. The Department of Revenue and Taxation *shall* issue  
26 on a priority basis a license for each type of activity being conducted at the  
27 Fair which requires a license from the Department. The Department of

1 Public Health and Social Services *shall* issue licenses for the preparation and  
2 sale of food. The Customs and Quarantine Agency *shall* provide information  
3 and assistance to participants concerning the importation requirements of the  
4 statutes of Guam, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and other agencies for  
5 importation of items into Guam for use at the Fair. The Department of  
6 Agriculture *shall* establish regulations for the judging of produce and  
7 livestock exhibited at the Fair.

8 The Mayors Council *shall* create a mechanism for village  
9 participation *or* competitions. The Guam Council on the Arts and  
10 Humanities Agency *shall* provide technical assistance to encourage public  
11 participation of the performing and fine arts. The Guam Police Department,  
12 the Guam Fire Department, Guam Homeland Security, and all other law  
13 enforcement entities of the government of Guam *shall* provide public safety  
14 support at the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race at  
15 the request of the Guam Visitors Bureau. The Guam Fire Department *shall*  
16 also inspect all booths and temporary structures to ensure compliance of Fire  
17 and Life Safety requirements, and issue required permits to operate such  
18 booths and temporary structures.

19 (c) *I Maga'lahi* (the Governor) *shall* appoint, from among the  
20 personnel of the departments and agencies mentioned in Subsection (b) of  
21 this Section, personnel to ensure the success of the Guam-Micronesia Island  
22 Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race. The Speaker, in consultation with the  
23 respective Chairpersons of the Committees on Economic Development and  
24 Tourism, *shall* designate representatives from *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature)  
25 to serve as members of the organizing committee.

26 (d) The Guam Visitors Bureau, in collaboration with the agencies  
27 listed in Subsection (b), *shall* establish a fee schedule for the conduct of the

1 Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race. The fee  
2 schedule *shall* include at a minimum: the cost for rental of display space; a  
3 participation fee to cover the costs of security, maintenance and other  
4 common area services at the Fair site; and a means by which food and  
5 beverage, produce, handicrafts, and other items being offered for sale may  
6 be purchased. All fees from the sale of goods or services sold at the Fair  
7 *shall* be collected and deposited to the Treasury of Guam. Twenty-five  
8 percent (25%) of the proceeds collected *shall* be deposited in the General  
9 Fund; fifty percent (50%) *shall* be deposited in the Guam-Micronesia Island  
10 Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race Revolving Fund, which is hereby created,  
11 to be administered by the Guam Visitors Bureau, for the sole purpose of  
12 paying for the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race-  
13 related expenses; and twenty-five percent (25%) shall be deposited in the  
14 FESTPAC 2016 Folklife Festival Trust Account.

15 (e) Within thirty (30) days of the close of each Guam-Micronesia  
16 Island Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race, the Guam Visitors Bureau *shall*  
17 report on the financial status of the Fair and the Guam-Micronesia Island  
18 Fair and Guam *Ko'Ko'* Road Race Revolving Fund to *I Maga'lahi* (the  
19 Governor) and the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, and *shall* make  
20 recommendations to improve the implementation of the Fair, including  
21 future sites and dates of the Fair and post the same on its website.”



## **Committee Report Digest**

### **1. OVERVIEW**

The Committee on Youth, Cultural Affairs, Procurement, General Government Operations and Public Broadcasting convened a public hearing on Wednesday June 22, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslatura*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 209-31 (COR)- “An act to amend §1033 of Chapter 10, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated; relative to including the Guam Ko’Ko’ Road Race as part of the Guam-Micronesian Island Fair, and to provide for support from the Guam Police Department and Guam Fire Department.”

Bill No. 209-31 (COR) would direct the Guam Police Department and the Guam Fire Department to provide public safety support for the Ko’Ko Road Race in addition to the services already mandated by the Department of Public Works, the Guam Visitors Bureau, Customs and Quarantine, the Department of Agriculture, and the Department of Revenue and Taxation.

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all senators on June 15<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

Mr. Chairman, the Guam Visitors Bureau thanks you and the Tourism Committee Chairwoman for seeing the importance of the Guam Micronesia Island Fair (GMIF) and the Guam Ko'ko' Road Race (GKRR).

GKRR began with an aspiration to further Guam's image in the sporting world and the desire to bring more attention to the plight of our native national bird, the ko'ko' and is an officially measured and authorized International Association of Athletics Federation (IAAF) half marathon.

GKRR began in 2006 with 309 runners. In the year 2010 we had over 1,600 registered participants. Within 5 years we grew the race participants over 400% making it one of the largest sporting events on the island.



A total of 673 participants came to Guam from Japan to participate in our 5<sup>th</sup> race. With the average travel companions being 3, we can estimate the race alone brought in 2,019 additional people to the island. With an average spend of \$499.00, the race participants and travel companions we can estimate our visitors on-island spending at over \$1 million.

By combining the two events, Guam adds value for all the participants and their accompanying friends and family. Affording all of them a unique cultural experience through the exhibits, demonstrations and other cultural activities at the Guam Micronesia Island Fair.

Collectively, the tourism industry has contributed to the Guam Police Department and the Guam Fire Department by providing equipment such as vehicles, ATV's, motorized mules, dirt bikes, wave-runners, jet skis, security cameras, bicycles, cell phones and assorted rescue gear that is used throughout the island.

By including the Guam Police Department and the Guam Fire Department we are able to ensure the safety of all participants as we strive to provide a quality event held to international standards as we continue to promote the island of Guam as a viable tourist destination.

Thank you for your vision to add the Guam Ko'ko' Road Race to the existing Guam Micronesia Island Fair public law and to include the Guam Police Department and Guam Fire Department to provide Government of Guam support for both events.

Dear Vice Speaker Cruz:

*Buenas yan Hafa Adai!* The Guam Police Department (GPD) supports events that encourage Micronesian hospitality and tourism. The Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and *Ko'ko'* Road Race are events which accomplish the goals of promoting Micronesian hospitality and tourism. Bill 209-31 (COR) –“An act to amend § 1033 of Chapter 10, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated; relative to including the Guam *Ko'ko'* Road Race as part of the Guam-Micronesian Island Fair, and to provide for support from the Guam and Guam Fire Department,” makes it mandatory for the Guam Police Department to provide public safety support at the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and *Ko'ko'* Road Race.

We support the intent of legislation to acknowledge the importance of public safety support by the Guam Police Department, but also with the caveat that Guam Police Department personnel may be redeployed from the event on a more serious public safety incident. There may be the possibility that the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and *Ko'ko'* Road Race may have to depend on private security services, because of the current limited resources of the Guam Police Department and the necessity for Guam Police Department operations to be focused toward an immediate public safety incident during the same period as the fair and race.



The Guam Fire Department hereby submits testimony in favor of Bill 209-31, **AN ACT TO AMEND § 1033 OF CHAPTER 10, TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO INCLUDING THE GUAM KO'KO' ROAD RACE AS PART OF THE GUAM-MICRONESIAN ISLAND FAIR, AND TO PROVIDE FOR SUPPORT FROM THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT AND GUAM FIRE DEPARTMENT.**

The Bill's intent in including the Ko'Ko' Road Race as part of the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair would make sense in that the two events are always held concurrently.

Since its inception and throughout all the years the Guam Fire Department has been in full support of the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and the Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race. The services that we have provided includes, the inspection of booths to ensure fire and life safety requirements are met; the issuance of permits to operate the booths; standby of our Emergency Responders/Units at the site of the fair; and, standby of our Rescue Units during the Ko'Ko' Road Race.

Along with GFD's full support of the Bill, we also recommend the following amendment.

**On Page 2, starting on Line 16 - 18, "paramount in the design. The Guam Fire Department shall inspect all booths and temporary structures to ensure compliance of Fire and Life Safety requirements and issue required permits to operate such booths and temporary structures.**

“The Department of Public Works shall inspect and ensure that the public facilities at the selected site are in good working condition to adequately protect the health and safety of the persons at the Fair.”

The Guam Fire Department is required by the Fire Code to inspect temporary booths/structures and issue permits to operate these booths, which is the reason that we request the above inclusion to the bill.

AN ACT TO AMEND § 1033 OF CHAPTER 10, TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO INCLUDING THE GUAM KO'KO' ROAD RACE AS PART OF THE GUAM-MICRONESIAN ISLAND FAIR, AND TO PROVIDE FOR SUPPORT FROM THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT AND GUAM FIRE DEPARTMENT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that  
3 since 2006, the Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race, an event intended to raise awareness for  
4 Guam's endangered official Territorial Bird and to attract international athletes to  
5 Guam, has become an annual addition to the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair. As the  
6 Road Race has become an integral part of the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair, it is  
7 appropriate that the event be an official function of the government of Guam and that  
8 the two events be joined and renamed the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam  
9 Ko'Ko' Road Race. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that public safety support

1 from the Guam Police Department and Guam Fire Department for the events is  
2 warranted.

3 **Section 2.** § 1033. of Chapter 10, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated is hereby  
4 *amended* to read:

5 "**§ 1033. Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race.**

- 6 (a) Annually, I Maga'lahaen Guahan (Governor) shall issue a proclamation calling  
7 upon the people of Guam to observe a Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam  
8 Ko'Ko' Road Race, which shall be held at the discretion of the Guam Visitors  
9 Bureau.
- 10 (b) The Guam Visitors Bureau shall be the organizing body for the Guam-  
11 Micronesia Island Fair and Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race and shall provide the  
12 necessary logistics and financial support to insure the success of the Fair as an  
13 international event and visitor attraction. The Department of Parks and  
14 Recreation shall assist by issuing permits for booths and exhibits, and designing  
15 the general layout of booths, exhibits and activities, with cultural awareness  
16 paramount in the design. The Department of Public Works shall inspect and  
17 ensure that the public facilities at the selected site are in good working condition  
18 to adequately protect the health and safety of the persons at the Fair. The  
19 Department of Revenue and Taxation shall issue on a priority basis a license for  
20 each type of activity being conducted at the Fair which requires a license from

1 the department. The Department of Public Health shall issue licenses for the  
2 preparation and sale of food. The Customs and Quarantine Department shall  
3 provide information and assistance to participants concerning the importation  
4 requirements of statutes and the U.S. Department of Agriculture and other  
5 agencies for importation of items into the territory for use at the Fair. The  
6 Department of Agriculture shall establish regulations for the judging of produce  
7 and livestock exhibited at the Fair. The Mayors Council shall create a  
8 mechanism for village participation or competitions. The Guam Council on the  
9 Arts and Humanities shall provide technical assistance to encourage public  
10 participation of the performing and fine arts. The Guam Police Department and  
11 the Guam Fire Department shall provide public safety support at the Guam-  
12 Micronesia Island Fair and Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race.

13 (c) The Governor shall appoint, from among the personnel of the departments and  
14 agencies mentioned in Subsection (b) of this Section, personnel to insure the  
15 success of the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race. The  
16 Speaker, in consultation with the respective Chairpersons of the Committees on  
17 Economic Development and Tourism, shall designate representatives from the  
18 Legislature to serve as members of the organizing committee.

19 (d) The Guam Visitors Bureau, in collaboration with the agencies listed in  
20 Subsection (b), shall establish a fee schedule for the conduct of the Guam-

1 Micronesia Island Fair and Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race. The fee schedule shall  
2 include at a minimum: the cost for rental of display space; a participation fee to  
3 cover the costs of security, maintenance and other common area services at the fair  
4 site; and, a means by which food and beverage, produce, handicrafts, and other  
5 items being offered for sale, may be purchased. All fees from the sale of goods or  
6 services sold at the Fair shall be collected and deposited to the Treasury of Guam.  
7 Twenty-five percent (25%) of the proceeds collected shall be deposited in the  
8 General Fund, fifty percent (50%) shall be deposited in the Guam-Micronesia  
9 Island Fair and Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race Revolving Fund, which is hereby  
10 created, to be administered by the Guam Visitors Bureau, for the sole purpose of  
11 paying for Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race -related  
12 expenses, with twenty-five percent (25%) to be deposited in the Guam, CNMI and  
13 Micronesian Student Loan Fund.

14 (e) Within thirty (30) days of the close of each Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and  
15 Guam Ko 'Ko' Road Race, the Guam Visitors Bureau shall report on the financial  
16 status of the Fair and the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair and Guam Ko'Ko' Road Race  
17 Revolving Fund to the Governor and the Speaker of Liheslaturan Guåhan, and shall  
18 make recommendations to improve the implementation of the Fair, including future  
19 sites and dates of the Fair and post the same on its website."

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
