



I. OVERVIEW

BILL NO. 281-31 (COR) - "AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (D) TO §9303 OF ARTICLE 3 CHAPTER 9 TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE TRANSMITTAL TO THE COMPILER OF LAWS THE ADOPTION, REPEAL, RECISSION OR AMENDMENT OF RULES AND REGULATIONS" was introduced by Senator Tina Muña Barnes on August 5, 2011; and was subsequently referred to the Committee on Rules; Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs; and Human and Natural Resources on the same day.

Senator Rory J. Respicio, Chairperson of the Committee on Rules; Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs; and Human and Natural Resources convened a public hearing on Bill 281 on Friday, October 7, 2011 at 2:00 P.M. in the Legislature's Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on the measure.




