AN ACT TO AMEND §§40105, 40111(b) AND 40113(b)(8), AND TO ADD A NEW §40135.1, ALL OF CHAPTER 40, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE MAYORS COUNCIL OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §40105 of Chapter 40, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby amended to read:
- 4 "§ 40105. Mayors Council. There is established a Mayors Council comprised of all Mayors and Vice Mayors. The Officers of the Council shall

consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and a Sergeant-at-Arms. Elections *shall* be held every two (2) years, with the first election to be conducted on the first Tuesday in January following the General Election. The Council *shall* adopt its own rules and by-laws; provided, that such rules and by-laws *do not* impede, restrict or in any way limit the authority of each Mayor within his district. Such rules and by-laws may be amended or revised from time to time upon a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the membership of the Council. A quorum of the Council *shall* consist of *not less than* sixty percent (60%) of the members, and no action of the Council shall be effective unless it shall be adopted by a majority of the membership."

Section 2. §40111 (b) of Chapter 40, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

"(b) Ceremony. The oaths of office *shall* be taken by the respective Mayors and Vice Mayors at the time their terms commence and the Executive Director of the Mayors Council (the Council) *shall* organize a suitable ceremony at which such oaths of office *shall* be administered by a Judge of the Superior Court or an outgoing Mayor or Vice Mayor. The Council *shall* determine the site of such ceremony and is authorized to expend thereon not to exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) from its annual budget. The Council (or its authorized representative) is hereby authorized to solicit monetary and in-kind donations for the purposes of defraying the cost of the ceremony."

Section 3. Subsection (b)(8) of §40113 of Chapter 40, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

"(8) The Mayor of *Inarajan* is responsible for Recreation Area I, Recreation Area II, the *Malojloj* Recreation Area, and the *Inarajan* Community Center. Administrative jurisdiction over the *Inarajan* Community Center is hereby transferred from the Department of Parks and Recreation to the *Inarajan* Mayor; provided, that the Mayor uses the Community Center for civic and community purposes. Such purposes may include, but are *not* limited to, a community and recreational center; a learning center; a museum; or a fishermen's and farmer's cooperative."

Section 4. A new §40135.1 is hereby *added* to Chapter 40, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated to read:

Revolving Fund. There is hereby established a Revolving Fund under the control and custody of the Mayors Council of Guam (the Council). The Mayors Council of Guam is hereby authorized to raise funds through fundraising efforts as approved by the Council, solicit corporate sponsorship, and to accept contributions that are *solely* beneficial to the Mayors Council of Guam. These revenues *shall* be deposited into the MCOG Revolving Fund, and *shall* be used to fund MCOG sanctioned programs, projects and special events. The Council *shall* take all necessary precautions to ensure that the Revolving Fund is operating in conformity with all existing statutes, rules and regulations, codes, executive orders, and any other authority which is applicable to the operations of the Revolving Fund. Any balance remaining in the funds at the end of the fiscal year *shall* carry over into the next fiscal year *or* until expended. All disbursement transactions on the Revolving Fund *shall* be as stipulated herein:

(a) the Mayors Council of Guam is hereby authorized to open a checking account for the purpose of establishing the Mayors Council of

Guam Revolving Fund, and for the purpose of keeping these funds 2 separate and apart from the General Fund; 3 (b) the Council shall approve all expenditures for MCOG 4 sanctioned programs, projects and special events; (c) the minutes of the MCOG meetings must verify the 5 6 authorization given by the Council; 7 (d) there must be two (2) authorized signatures; authorized 8 signatures shall be that of the President and Treasurer of the Council. If 9 a temporary absence occurs in either the office of the President or 10 Treasurer, then the order of succession of the Officers who shall be eligible to serve in an acting capacity shall be recognized as an 11 12 authorized signature; 13 (e) the Treasurer (or the Council's authorized representative) shall 14 be responsible for receipts and other substantiation as determined by the 15 Council for all checks issued. 16 (f) No later than thirty (30) days after the end of every fiscal 17 quarter, the President of the Mayors Council of Guam shall submit to the 18 Public Auditor of Guam and the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and 19 post on its website, in written and electronic format (including, but not 20 limited to, diskettes, CDs and email) a report making full disclosure of 21 the Mayors Council of Guam Revolving Fund. Said report shall be in the 22 form of financial statements or revenue and expenditure reports for the 23 Mayors Council of Guam Revolving Fund." Section 5. Effective Date. The provisions of this Act shall be effective upon 24

Section 6. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity *shall* not affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 522-31 (COR) – "An Act to Amend §40105 of Chapter 40, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated Relative to the Term of Office for Officers of The Mayors' Council of Guam."

Bill No. 522-31(COR) was introduced on October 3, 2012 by Senator Tina Rose Muña Barnes, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Recreation on October 5, 2012.

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Recreation convened a public hearing on Bill No. 522-31(COR) on Monday, October 29, 2012 at 9:00 AM at the Legislature's Public Hearing Room.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via e-mail to all Senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Monday, October 22, 2012 (5-Day Notice), and again on Wednesday, October 24, 2012 (48-Hour Notice).

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Muña Barnes

Next bill on the agenda ladies and gentlemen is Bill No. 522-31 (COR) An Act to Amend §40105 of Chapter 40, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated Relative to the Term of Office for Officers of the Mayors' Council of Guam. Bill No. 522-31 (COR)'s main intent ladies and gentlemen is to amend the current process for the election of officers within the Mayors' Council of Guam. The current law, §40105 of Chapter 40, 5 GCA stipulates that the officers of the Council shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and a Sergeant-at-Arms, and that elections shall be held on the first Tuesday of each January. It is at the request of the Council that these elections be conducted every two (2) years in January as opposed to conducting the elections every January. Therefore,

the proposed amendment would eventually extend the current term of the officers from one (1) year to two (2) years. And here to speak on the bill I do have the Executive Director Mr. Angel Sablan, Mayor Gumataotao and of course anyone else here at the table. Just state your name for the record.

Angel Sablan, MCOG Executive Director

Once again, Angel Sablan, the Executive Director for the Mayors' Council of Guam. This bill has come up, the proposal has come up because it has mention several times during the meetings of the Mayors' Council. And I know initially proposed by Mayor Robert Lizama of Yigo to why not change the terms of office instead of us electing every year the officers of the Mayors' Council of Guam, why don't you just make it 2 years because a 1 year term is very short and by the time the President and the officers to get use to what they do as officers, their term is up and it's time again for another election. And also it may be a subtle way of saving the government some money. You know we have an inauguration of officers every year and that also takes expenses, so maybe we save some money by making it every 2 years instead of every year. And it would have been okay if the by-laws and the constitution of the Mayors' Council of Guam had it not been codified in law, but the election has to happen every year. So that's why we came back to the legislature to ask to for your support to change it to every 2 years. And again this was brought forth at our Special Meeting a few weeks ago and the Mayors and Vice Mayors supported the intent. Thank you.

I'm Mayor Ben Gumataotao again... Anyway, this thing is not only that you save money and time, because time is an essence especially at my age. But I hope that you Senators will come up with 3-year terms instead of every 2 years. It would be a lot better because we're wasting too much money and time by having every 2 years for the legislature and for us we make it every 2 years. I recommend that you come up with another bill for that for you people to come to 3 years. Thank you.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §40105 of Chapter 40, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended read:

"§40105. Mayors Council. There is established a Mayors Council comprising of all Mayors and Vice Mayors. [The officers of the Council shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.] The officers of the Council shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and a Sergeant-at-Arms. Elections shall be held every two (2) years, with the first election to be conducted on the first Tuesday [of each] in January following the general election. The Council shall adopt its own rules and by-laws, provided that such rules and by-laws do not impede, restrict or in any way limit the authority of each Mayor within his district. Such rules and by-laws may be amended or revised from time to time upon a vote of two-thirds of the membership of the Council. A quorum of the Council shall consist of not less than sixty percent (60%) of the members
