



BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §3202(j) and (k) of Article 2 of Chapter 3, Title 19, Guam Code
Annotated, are hereby *amended* to read:

“(j) All applicants electing to have their marriage solemnized by a
village mayor or vice mayor *shall* pay to the Mayors Council of Guam
Revolving Fund the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), which *shall* be paid at

least three (3) days prior to the date of the marriage ceremony. The Mayors Council of Guam treasurer *shall* transfer the amount to the appropriate officiating municipality's non-appropriated funds (NAF) village account.

(k) The Mayors of Council of Guam *shall* submit a quarterly report in writing to the Speaker of *I Liheslatura*, to include, but not limited to, the name of the mayor or vice-mayor performing the civil wedding ceremony, the total number of civil weddings each mayor or vice-mayor performed each month, the names of the individuals for which the ceremony was performed, the date of the wedding, and the amount of money collected for all civil weddings performed. This information *shall* be posted monthly on the Mayors Council of Guam website.”



COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

Bill No. 106-31 (COR) – “An act to *amend* §3202(j) to Chapter 3, Title 19 GCA relative to the payment for solemnization of marriage by a Mayor or Vice Mayor.” – sponsored by Senator Tina Rose Muña Barnes

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement and Judiciary convened the public hearing on April 8, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 106-31 (COR) - “An act to *amend* §3202(j) to Chapter 3, Title 19 GCA relative to the payment for solemnization of marriage by a Mayor or Vice Mayor,” sponsored by Senator Tina Rose Muña Barnes.

Public Hearing Requirements

Notices of the hearing were disseminated via facsimile and email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on April 1, 2011 (5-day Notice) and on April 5, 2011 (48-Hour notice), pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. convened the public hearing for the Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement and Judiciary at 1:30 p.m., read the title of the bill and deferred to the author to summarize its contents.

Senator Tina Rose Muña Barnes said that the payment for solemnization of marriages by mayors is made to the Department of Public Health and Social Services and that it is difficult to gain access to those funds. The mayors' suggestion is to make the payment payable to the Mayor's Council of Guam.

Chairman Palacios called the panel of Mayor Robert Lizama and Executive Director Angel Sablan to testify.

Mayor Robert Lizama stated that the marriage license and marriage fee is paid for Mayors to solemnize a marriage. The money has not made it to the Mayor's Offices, which has hampered their ability to use those funds to improve services in the villages. He suggests that the Mayor's Council should be avoided entirely, to streamline the process, and make it so that people can pay directly to the Mayor's Office. Mayor Lizama suggests that maybe there does not need to be a three (3) day waiting period. He suggests that subsection (k) also be dealt with by amendment or repeal.

Senator Muna Barnes said that she can help track funds and ensure that the funds are transferred.

Executive Director Angel Sablan stated that the Mayor's Council of Guam has not received any money from the solemnization of marriages. He requested that the bill be amended so that the funds will go directly to the individual Mayor's Offices because it is more convenient to the constituents. He stated that they can go into their non-appropriated accounts, which are subject to quarterly reports and audits. He said that Mayors do not need the three (3) days that are provided in the Bill.

Chairman Palacios stated that he believes the funds should be transferred to the Mayor's Office in accordance with the law. He wants there to be adequate checks that there is accountability of funds received from the constituents. Mr. Sablan stated that there are controls on funds. Mr. Sablan said that the license must be returned to Public Health with the receipt to register the marriage. Mayor Lizama stated that all the mayors are required to make reports on the funds they handle. The Chairman suggested a procedure to assure accountability. Mayor Lizama gives an example of a contractor which is reluctant to perform because of concerns regarding payment.

Senator V. Anthony Ada asked if there is an estimate of how much is owed by the Department of Administration to the Mayor's Council. Mr. Lizama stated that there is over ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) that should be received for marriage solemnization.

Senator Muna Barnes suggested if there was an officiating fee, the mayors must receive funds to perform the marriage.

Chairman Palacios reiterated his desire for accountability.

Vice Chairman Thomas C. Ada said that he does not often perform weddings. He stated that he does not believe that there needs to be a charge for conducting weddings.

Mayor Lizama stated that the constituents appreciate getting married by their mayors.

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr., declared that Bill No. 106-31(COR) is duly heard. The Chairman concluded the hearing and requested that written testimony be submitted within the next ten (10) days. He adjourned the hearing at 2:40 p.m.

III. WRITTEN TESTIMONIES

No written testimony was received within the ten (10) day period after the public hearing.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 2. Subsection §3202 (j), Chapter 3, Title 19, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby
amended to read:

“§3202. Marriage Licenses.

(j) All applicants electing to have their marriage solemnized by a village mayor
or vice mayor *shall* pay to the ~~Treasurer of Guam~~ Mayor's Council of Guam Revolving Fund
Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), which *shall accompany the application for a marriage license be paid at*
least three (3) days prior to the date of the marriage ceremony. The Mayor's Council of Guam
treasurer shall transfer the amount to the appropriate officiating municipality's Non-
Appropriated Funds (NAF) village account. A copy of the marriage license shall be submitted by
the applicants to the mayor or vice mayor's office showing payment of the fee.
