AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (c) OF §5123, **RELATIVE** TO THE **MAINTENANCE OF** GOVERNMENT **VEHICLES**; TO **ADD** A **NEW** SUBSECTION (e) TO §5123**.** RELATIVE TO THE MANDATING **PURCHASE** OR LEASE OF VEHICLES BY THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM THAT **MEET EXCEED** OR Α **MINIMUM** AVERAGE COMBINED CITY AND HIGHWAY MILES TWENTY-FIVE MILES GALLON (MPG) OF PER GALLON (25 MPG): AND TO ADD**NEW** SUBSECTION (f) TO §5123 OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO ALLOW CERTAIN SPECIALIZED VEHICLES TO BE EXCLUDED FROM THE MILES PER GALLON STANDARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Statement. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to mandate that the procurement of vehicles by the government of Guam includes a requirement of meeting or exceeding a minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon standard of twenty-five miles per gallon (25 mpg), as determined by the United States Department of Energy's (USDOE) rating of vehicle fuel economy as contained on its website at www.fueleconomy.gov. It is also recognized by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* that there are vehicles required to perform various governmental functions that are to be excluded from the mandate established by this Act.
 - **Section 2.** A new Subsection (e) is *added* to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read:
 - "(e) **Minimum Combined Miles Per Gallon Standard.** All vehicles to be purchased or leased for use by the government of Guam *shall* meet or exceed a minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon of twenty-five miles per gallon (25 mpg), as determined by the United States Department of Energy's (USDOE) rating of vehicle fuel economy as contained on its website at www.fueleconomy.gov. This standard *shall* be reviewed every 3 years."
 - **Section 3.** A new Subsection (f) is *added* to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, to read:
 - "(f) **Excluded Vehicles.** The Chief Procurement Officer *shall* prepare and maintain a listing of those vehicles that are excluded from the minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon standard. The types of vehicles that are to be excluded include, but are *not* limited to: law enforcement vehicles; vehicles whose primary function is to carry cargo;

specialized utility vehicles; construction vehicles; and any other vehicle whose primary function is other than the transportation of five (5) passengers or fewer. For the purposes of this Section, the Procurement Officers of the Judiciary of Guam, the Guam Legislature, and any government of Guam entity *not* subject to the Chief Procurement Officer's procurement review, *shall* prepare and maintain a listing of those vehicles that are excluded from the minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon standard as defined herein."

Section 4. Subsection (c) of §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

"(c) The Chief Procurement Officer *shall* include preventative maintenance services for a period of *no less than* 3 years when procuring the vehicle fleet. He shall also determine, by requesting for proposals, whether it would be less costly to contract for fleet maintenance with private businesses; and if less costly, using either separate contracts for purchase and maintenance or a combined contract for purchase and maintenance from one source, he shall so contract for the maintenance of the fleet for a minimum of 3 years from the date of purchase of the vehicle. In any maintenance contract, there *shall* be inserted provisions requiring that the maintenance be performed within a certain period of time or liquidated damages assessed against the contractor."

Gas prices up by 10 cents, could pose economic concerns

FOR the second time in a month, gas prices saw another 10-cent increase yesterday.

Mobil has raised the price of regular unleaded gas from \$4.87 to \$4.97 per gallon. As of yesterday afternoon, 76 and Shell gas stations had not increased their prices, but they traditionally follow suit.

Gary Hiles, chief economist with the Department of Labor, said a 10-cent-per-gallon increase could cost Guam consumers about \$4.5 million annually if the increase remained for a year.

The increase could lead to more economical concerns, such as higher electrical rates and prices for goods.

He said since gasoline has become a significant portion of a household's expense, the rise in gas prices will result in a reduction in the quantity of gas purchased, but more money spent on gas, which would leave less for expenditures on other items.

Hiles added that the visitor industry will be affected if jet fuel prices increase, as most of the visitors to Guam are transported by jets. If jet prices increase, so would travel to Guam.

According to Guam Energy Office statistics, oil companies sold about 45 million gallons of gas on Guam in 2012. The total dollar value of gasoline sold on Guam at the current price would be about \$224 million annually.

Hafa Adai Vice-Speaker Cruz:

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on proposed legislation of Bill 14-32(COR). The Department of Administration (DOA) and the General Services Agency (GSA) have reviewed Bill 14-32 and have the following comments:

Bill 14-32 recognizes that soaring gasoline prices are costing government of Guam agencies and departments more funds which impact its operational needs. The intent is to require that a minimal standard be established for the purchase of government vehicles in the future and to exclude said requirement for certain vehicles.

We agree with the intent of the bill. However, we believe that setting the minimum gasoline mileage requirements is not effective in and of itself. Regular required maintenance will not only extend the life of a vehicle, but will be a cost savings to the government in the long run as well. To that extent, Bill 376-31 was introduced in the last legislature that attempts to address a more comprehensive review of the procurement of government vehicles.

Although current vehicle purchases are usually accomplished using federal grant funding, Bill 376-31 was an act that would standardize the purchase of all vehicles for all government agencies. The intention of this bill would centralize the procurement of all government vehicles to the Chief Procurement Officer by insuring that categories designed in the law are followed. Further, that all purchases of vehicles come with maintenance for at least five (5) years. The purchasing of these vehicles will be done based upon an overall government need, rather than just an agency decision. This bill also forces agencies and departments to follow a maintenance

schedule or face the consequence of losing the ability to purchase a new vehicle for the next fiscal year. Except for the provision in Bill 376-31 stating that all government agencies and departments shall participate in the cost of obtaining maintenance agreements, we whole heartily approve this bill and hope that all of the senators see the benefit of such an action.

We recommend that bill 14-32 be merged with the requirements stated in Bill 376-31 excluding the provision relative to the pooling of maintenance cost. In the event local appropriations provide for the purchase of government vehicles or the federal grant allows, this merger will be a more effective way of purchasing government vehicles.

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §(e) TO §5123 OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO MANDATING THE PURCHASE OR LEASE OF VEHICLES BY THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM SHALL MEET OR EXCEED A MINIMUM AVERAGE COMBINED CITY AND HIGHWAY MILES PER GALLON (MPG) OF TWENTY-FIVE MILES PER GALLON (25 MPG); TO ADD A NEW §(f) TO §5123 OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO ALLOW CERTAIN SPECIALTY VEHICLES TO BE EXCLUDED FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Statement. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to mandate that the procurement of vehicles by the government of Guam includes a requirement of meeting or exceeding a minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon standard of Twenty-five miles per gallon (25mpg), as determined by the United States Department of Energy's (USDOE) rating of vehicle fuel economy as contained on its website at www.fueleconomy.gov. It is also recognized by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* that there are vehicles required to perform various governmental functions that are to be excluded from the mandate established by this Act.

- Section 2. A new §(e) is added to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated. A new §(e) is added to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read:
- "(e) Minimum Combined Miles Per Gallon Standard. All vehicles to be purchased or leased for use by the government of Guam shall meet or exceed a minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon of Twenty-five miles per gallon (25mpg), as determined by the United States Department of Energy's (USDOE) rating of vehicle fuel economy as contained on its website at www.fueleconomy.gov."

Section 3. A new §(f) is added to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated. A new §(f) is added to §5123 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read:

"(f) Excluded Vehicles. The Chief Procurement Officer shall prepare and maintain a listing of those vehicles that are excluded from the minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon standard. The type of vehicles that are to be excluded includes, but is not limited to: law enforcement vehicles; vehicles whose primary function is to carry cargo; specialized utility vehicles; construction vehicles; and any other vehicle whose primary function is other than the transportation of five (5) passengers or fewer. For purposes of this Section, the Procurement Officers for the Judiciary of Guam, the Guam Legislature, and any government of Guam entity *not* subject to the Chief Procurement Officer's procurement review, shall prepare and maintain a listing of those vehicles that are excluded from the minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon standard as defined herein."

Senator Duenas stated that Bill No. 14-32 (COR) is a straightforward bill that if enacted mandate the purchase or lease of vehicles by the government of Guam so that they shall meet or exceed a minimum average combined city and highway miles per gallon (MPG) of twenty-five miles per gallon (25 MPG). Senator Duenas stated that the legislation was generated from an OPA report that listed the exorbitant amount of money the government of Guam paying for fuel. Senator Duenas stated that he considers Bill No. 14-32 (COR) to be a starter piece of legislation to get the discussion going on fuel and money conservation. 
