The Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation may adopt rules to implement the provisions of this Section. *Except* for a new or renewed registration, applications for the issuance of gold star license plates *shall* be processed in the order received by the Department subject to normal workflow considerations. The fee for the issuance of gold star license plates is hereby waived."

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 24-32 (COR) was introduced on January 25, 2013 by Senator V. Anthony Ada, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on January 29, 2013.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on Bill No. 33-32 (COR) on February 12, 2013 at 10:10 a.m. in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. The hearing was adjourned at 10:55 a.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas: We will begin public testimony for Bill 24-32. I'd like to now yield to the author, Senator Frank Aguon, for his opening statement.

Senator Frank Aguon, Jr.: Thank you very much, Mister Chairman and thank you very much for conducting the public hearing on this particular legislation. It's interesting how legislative measures are conceived. Just two days into having assumed this responsibility, apparently I received a call from a mother of a fallen hero. She inquired why, when other benefits are extended to veterans, is it that this particular benefit could not be extended. Because of that particular conversation, that is why we have Bill No. 24. Please be mindful that this has been part of the law with the exception of the waiver of the fees. I want to thank Rev and Tax for providing some initial information. In terms of the cost, it is \$21.86 per license plate as it applies to the Golden Star as referenced in Bill 24. Thank you very much, Mister Chairman. I certainly look forward to the dialogue and conversation and the testimonies that may be provided today.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Senator Aguon. Are there any members of the community who wish to testify with regards to Bill 24-32? If no community testimony, are there any Senators who would like to comment on Bill 24-32?

Senator Tom Ada: Thank you, Mister Chairman. Certainly, in principle, I'm supportive of the bill to provide some additional benefits to Gold Star mothers and widows. Although I am concerned and I noticed there are representative here from Rev and Tax and they have not chosen to testify on the bill. For one, I would like to hear their understanding of the bill itself because what the bill proposes to do is basically waive the fee for the issuance of the Gold Star plate. It is unclear if that waiver of fees is the same as the waiver of fees for vehicle registrations for veterans with 100% disability. In other words, when they register their vehicle, they waive the street light fee, the abandoned vehicle fee and the vehicle license plate fee. It is then to be accorded to the widow, the mother, the father of the deceased. I hope that we get a chance to get that clarification of Rev and Tax's understanding of how they would apply this bill, if passed. Thank you.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Senator Ada. In the audience we do have the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation. Would you like to comment on the concerns of Senator Ada?

Mr. John Camacho: Sure. Members of the Committee... Mister Chairman. Although I was not prepared to testify on this bill, I will surely like to meet with my staff at the Department of Motor Vehicles to know the aspects of what can be waived and what cannot be waived. I'll be happy to get back to you and to report to you on another day.

Chairman San Nicolas: Are there any other Senators who wish to comment?

Speaker Judith Won Pat: Thank you very much, Mister Chairman. I would like to also ask, when you get the information from your staff, that you provide to the Chairman and to members of the committee what all the different waivers of fees. Senator Tom Ada had indicated that there is the waiver of registration fees. Are there any others that maybe this Legislature would like to get the whole picture of? Bits and pieces of these are being done and we don't even know exactly what the impact is.

Mr. Camacho: Sure, Madame Speaker. I will get that report to the Chairperson and members of the committee.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Speaker Won Pat. Any other Senators wish to comment on this bill?

Sen. Tom Ada: If I may, since we are talking about waiver of fees. I would just ask also that when the Director go back, to make sure that the Rev and Tax staff understands the other fee waivers that are accorded to veterans. For example, for all veterans, the driver's license fee is waived. That has always been the case for a long time. What has changed recently is that, before a veteran had to go down to the Veteran's Office in Asan and show documentation that he is, in fact, a bonafide veteran. Then he has to go all the way to Barrigada and show him that letter. A law was passed a couple of years ago which said that the guy at Rev and Tax can see for himself the same verification documents – DD214, his retired ID card – to show that he is a bonafide veteran. And still, I come across veterans who are told that they are following that law – they come up there with their DD214 with their retired ID card – and they still get told, "Go down to Asan to get this certification that says, 'Yes, you are a veteran." And I know because I have experienced the very same thing until I stood there and insisted.

Mr. Camacho: Senator, I know that was a problem and I thought that problem was rectified. I will, again, stress the new law that came into play and we will follow that law. I will ensure that, Senator.

Sen. Tom Ada: I will say that at least in my case, it was resolved there. There was somebody that did know how to handle it. Thank you.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Senator Ada. If there is no further testimony on this bill, we will go ahead and conclude the hearing on Bill 24-32.







COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 24-32 (COR) was introduced on January 25, 2013 by Senator V. Anthony Ada, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on January 29, 2013.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on Bill No. 33-32 (COR) on February 12, 2013 at 10:10 a.m. in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. The hearing was adjourned at 10:55 a.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas: We will begin public testimony for Bill 24-32. I'd like to now yield to the author, Senator Frank Aguon, for his opening statement.

Senator Frank Aguon, Jr.: Thank you very much, Mister Chairman and thank you very much for conducting the public hearing on this particular legislation. It's interesting how legislative measures are conceived. Just two days into having assumed this responsibility, apparently I received a call from a mother of a fallen hero. She inquired why, when other benefits are extended to veterans, is it that this particular benefit could not be extended. Because of that particular conversation, that is why we have Bill No. 24. Please be mindful that this has been part of the law with the exception of the waiver of the fees. I want to thank Rev and Tax for providing some initial information. In terms of the cost, it is \$21.86 per license plate as it applies to the Golden Star as referenced in Bill 24. Thank you very much, Mister Chairman. I certainly look forward to the dialogue and conversation and the testimonies that may be provided today.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Senator Aguon. Are there any members of the community who wish to testify with regards to Bill 24-32? If no community testimony, are there any Senators who would like to comment on Bill 24-32?

Senator Tom Ada: Thank you, Mister Chairman. Certainly, in principle, I'm supportive of the bill to provide some additional benefits to Gold Star mothers and widows. Although I am concerned and I noticed there are representative here from Rev and Tax and they have not chosen to testify on the bill. For one, I would like to hear their understanding of the bill itself because what the bill proposes to do is basically waive the fee for the issuance of the Gold Star plate. It is unclear if that waiver of fees is the same as the waiver of fees for vehicle registrations for veterans with 100% disability. In other words, when they register their vehicle, they waive the street light fee, the abandoned vehicle fee and the vehicle license plate fee. It is then to be accorded to the widow, the mother, the father of the deceased. I hope that we get a chance to get that clarification of Rev and Tax's understanding of how they would apply this bill, if passed. Thank you.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Senator Ada. In the audience we do have the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation. Would you like to comment on the concerns of Senator Ada?

Mr. John Camacho: Sure. Members of the Committee... Mister Chairman. Although I was not prepared to testify on this bill, I will surely like to meet with my staff at the Department of Motor Vehicles to know the aspects of what can be waived and what cannot be waived. I'll be happy to get back to you and to report to you on another day.

Chairman San Nicolas: Are there any other Senators who wish to comment?

Speaker Judith Won Pat: Thank you very much, Mister Chairman. I would like to also ask, when you get the information from your staff, that you provide to the Chairman and to members of the committee what all the different waivers of fees. Senator Tom Ada had indicated that there is the waiver of registration fees. Are there any others that maybe this Legislature would like to get the whole picture of? Bits and pieces of these are being done and we don't even know exactly what the impact is.

Mr. Camacho: Sure, Madame Speaker. I will get that report to the Chairperson and members of the committee.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Speaker Won Pat. Any other Senators wish to comment on this bill?

Sen. Tom Ada: If I may, since we are talking about waiver of fees. I would just ask also that when the Director go back, to make sure that the Rev and Tax staff understands the other fee waivers that are accorded to veterans. For example, for all veterans, the driver's license fee is waived. That has always been the case for a long time. What has changed recently is that, before a veteran had to go down to the Veteran's Office in Asan and show documentation that he is, in fact, a bonafide veteran. Then he has to go all the way to Barrigada and show him that letter. A law was passed a couple of years ago which said that the guy at Rev and Tax can see for himself the same verification documents – DD214, his retired ID card – to show that he is a bonafide veteran. And still, I come across veterans who are told that they are following that law – they come up there with their DD214 with their retired ID card – and they still get told, "Go down to Asan to get this certification that says, 'Yes, you are a veteran." And I know because I have experienced the very same thing until I stood there and insisted.

Mr. Camacho: Senator, I know that was a problem and I thought that problem was rectified. I will, again, stress the new law that came into play and we will follow that law. I will ensure that, Senator.

Sen. Tom Ada: I will say that at least in my case, it was resolved there. There was somebody that did know how to handle it. Thank you.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Senator Ada. If there is no further testimony on this bill, we will go ahead and conclude the hearing on Bill 24-32.

III. RECOMMENDATIONS





AN ACT TO AMEND §7120.3 OF CHAPTER 7, TITLE 16, OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO WAIVER OF FEES FOR IMMEDIATE KIN OF FALLEN HEROES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of §7120.3, Chapter 7, Title 16 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended to read:

"§ 7120.3. Special Gold Star License Plates.

(a) The Motor Vehicle Division of the Department of Revenue and Taxation shall, upon application, issue gold star license plates. The type and style of the gold star plates shall be determined by the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation and the Office of Veterans Affairs, except that a gold star shall appear on one (1) side of the plate. Applicants shall apply on forms prescribed by the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation, and the applicant's eligibility will be certified by the Office of Veterans Affairs. The plates shall be re-issued only to the original holder of the plates. The Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation may adopt rules to implement the provisions of this Section. Except for a new or renewed registration, applications for the issuance of

2	subject to normal workflow considerations. The fee for the issuance of gold
3	star plates shall not exceed the fee charged for a similar license plate for the
4	same class of vehicle is hereby waived.
5	Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective within thirty (30) days
