The Legislature's intent is to transfer jurisdiction of the Port Authority of Guam (PAG) over Lot 127 in the municipality of Piti to the jurisdiction of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission (GALC). PAG's adoption of overall master plan did not include subject property and other contiguous properties after a quitclaim from the federal government. Passage of the Bill will leave GALC the chance to eventually take steps to return subject property to the original landowners as mandated.

II. COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS

Chairman Pangelinan: The next item on the agenda is Bill No. 7-32 (COR), An act to add a new §80105 (i) to Chapter 80 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the transfer of property under the jurisdiction of the Port Authority of Guam to the jurisdiction of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission.

The bill was introduced by Speaker Judith Won Pat. We have signed up to testify Mr. Patrick S.N. Iriarte and Mr. Felix Pangelinan from the Port Authority of Guam. Speaker Won Pat will present a synopsis of the bill.

(a) Bill Sponsor Summary

Speaker Judith Won Pat: Thank you Mr. Chairman. Last term, the 31st Guam Legislature, a bill was introduced to have certain properties return to the government that are part of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission and in turn we try to return them to the families. There is one particular family in that series of names that came out that have been located. So we are doing this piece meal. If you recall, this bill is like the bill introduced last term.

At least in testimonies that were given last time, I want the committee report to reflect that the Port Authority did say that they do support it and have the properties returned to the original landowners. Thank you.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you very much Speaker Won Pat. We will go ahead and begin with Mr. Iriarte.

(b) Testimony

1. Mr. Partrick S.N. Iriarte

Mr. Patrick S.N. Iriarte: Thank you very much and manana si yu'os ma'ase' para hamyo todus. Si yu'os ma'ase' Speaker and Vice Speaker and the rest of Guam's finest here. I would like to elongate the support of every senator here to sign off on awarding this land and blessing what we didn't know we had when it was first introduced in 2009.

We found out last year and we just want to thank you from the bottom of our hearts. I am representing my mother's interest, Rosario Wusstig San Nicolas, on this bill. Thank you.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Mr. Pangelinan, thank you and si yu'os ma'ase' for yourtestimony. We also received written testimony from the Department of Land Management. For the record they are also in support of the bill.

We also have Mr. Ricky Rapolla and Mr. Raymond Rapolla Borja who signed up and are in support of Bill 7-32 (COR). Sir, please identify yourself for the record and also present your testimony.

3. Mr. Ricky Rapolla

Mr. Ricky Rapolla Borja: For the record my name is Ricky Rapolla Borja. I am here for the bill to give back the land to the landowners. I am representing my grandmother Carlina San Nicolas Rapolla. My mother passed away a long time ago. The family had a rice plantation and all of the sudden they were taken by the military. You know how when they really want support the military here without asking for any kind of compensation or what they just went away and the military just started building on it.

We never got an update on what's happening there. I Just heard that there will be land given back to the San Nicolas family. My brother and I wanted to come here and find out about the bill. I see there is only one issue here - the big man from the Port saying that they still want to make something out of it.

I am here to get back our ancestral land from the Guam Ancestral Land Commission. To put it all into perspective to give it back to the owners. I would like to thank everybody and especially Judi Won Pat for introducing this bill because I would have never known and I am pretty sure if the family had known or put out an announcement. That's all I have to say for now until the hearing. I just want to show that I'm for the bill. When I saw that he [referring to Mr. Iriarte] was the only one it gave me more courage to come up here and talk. Thank you.

PANEL COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you very much. Senator Ysrael, please come and join the others.

4. Mr. Al Ysrael, Former Senator, 12th Guam Legislature

Mr. Al Ysrael: Thank you Mr. Chairman for the notice. I am here originally to testify for the GEDA bill but when I saw the 12 illustrious men and ladies in front of me as a captive audience I couldn't help resist making comments on the autonomous agency of the Port together with the many other autonomous agencies that the legislature has created in the past.

The autonomous agencies of Guam have become untouchable. They have become an empire and an entity on their own, responsible to no one, not even to the Legislature. How many times has the Legislature asked for documentation from the autonomous agencies? They are supposed to be semi-autonomous but they became autonomous agencies without any checks or balances.

In particular, returning this land back to the government of Guam where it naturally belongs is an excellent idea. In particular, the biggest violator is the Guam International Airport Authority. They have huge tracts of valuable land and they have become or are in the process of becoming the largest non-taxed paying landlords on the island. This is the stated goal of their Vice Chairman, Mr. Santos. He made it as a public statement last month. I thought I kept it but I couldn't find it in my records

But as an example the land under the control of this autonomous agencies do not pay gross receipts tax, do not pay income tax and do not pay real estate taxes. Therefore, they are in the position of offering land to private enterprises at the rate of, for example, four cents a square foot monthly rental. To add insult to injury this monthly rental is not paid until the 6th to the 15th year that rental payment is deferred. No one can control their actions.

PANEL COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Senator....

Mr. Al Ysrael: I know; going too far. Make this as comprehensive as possible. Include all the autonomous agencies in this comprehensive bill as a suggestion. Bring back the autonomous agencies under the control of the government of Guam.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: We have a bill to resolve some of those issues very soon.

Mr. Al Ysrael: Thank you. I couldn't resist the twelve captive audiences.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: I know. Thank you very much [former] Senator Ysrael. Si yu'os ma'ase.

Thank you very much, si yu'os ma'ase. Gentlemen thank you very much for your testimony. This concludes the testimony on Bill No. 7-32 (COR). BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslatura finds that certain ancestral lands in the municipalities of Piti, Sumay and Agat were condemned under Civil Action No. 5-49 by the Naval Government of Guam creating the Apra Harbor Reservation Boundary. Eventually, the United States quitclaimed portions of the Apra Harbor Reservation to the Government of Guam in December 1984 containing certain parcels, with eventual transfer to the Commercial Port of Guam, now known as the Port Authority of Guam (PAG), for development. In formal conferences and legislative session meetings between the PAG and I Liheslatura (the Legislature), it has been stated by the PAG board, management, and personnel that the PAG does not have any future plans for the development or use of certain portions of the parcels under their jurisdiction.

Therefore, *I Liheslatura* intends to transfer such land parcels and properties to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission, so that the Guam Ancestral Lands

1 Commission can and shall proceed with the return of such land parcels and

properties to the original landowners or their estates, pursuant to the Commission's

Section 2. A new §80105(i) is hereby *added* to §80105 of Chapter 80, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

Portions of Parcel 1 South of Route 18 and contiguous to the North of Apra Harbor Parcel 6, also abutting Marine Corps Drive on the east, specifically original lot: No. 127 PI, originally owned by the Estate of Maria Salas San Nicolas, Antonia Salas San Nicolas, Carlina San Nicolas Rapolla, Joaquin S. San Nicolas, Juan S. San Nicolas, Maria S.-CI# 8383, San Nicolas, Dolores Wusstig San Nicolas, Rosario San Nicolas Iriarte, Consolacion S. San Nicolas, Ignacia San Nicolas Aflleje, Dolores C. San Nicolas, and Ana San Nicolas Sanford, in the municipality of Piti. The property shall be transferred and shall be deeded to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Act. The Guam Ancestral Lands Commission shall within one hundred eighty (180) days dispose of the land parcel and lot transferred by this Act in a manner consistent with and pursuant to its enabling legislation and its mandates. All pre-condemnation roads, easements and bull cart trails shall remain as easements for public access and utilities. The transferred property shall be zoned "A" - Agricultural zone."

Section 3. The Department of Land Management *shall* plot, plan, design, and provide within sixty (60) days of enactment an aerial overlay map delineating all roads, easements, bull-cart trails, and public access as to determine such access or easements' location in relation to the return subject Lot so that *no* Lot is landlocked. The overlay *shall* show all original Lot lines generally.

Section 4. Severability. If any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

Subject: Testimony on Bill Number 07-32

Bueñas Yan Hafa Adai: The Department has reviewed Bill Number 07-32 - An Act to Add a New §80105(i) to Chapter 80 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, Relative to the Jurisdiction of the Port Authority of Guam (PAG) to the Jurisdiction of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission. The intent of this legislative proposal is to allow the transfer of previously quitclaimed portions of the Apra Harbor Reservation to the Guam Ancestral Land Commission¹. This Bill makes particular reference to Lot 127 in the municipality of Piti. We fully support Bill 07-32 based on the following:

- 1. Lot 127 is one of various contiguous parcels that have since been returned under the auspice of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission (GALC) for the purpose of returning such lands to original landowners and/or their heirs. Consistency exists with regards to encouraging eventual transfer of ownership of lands to owners whom in turn have waited over 60 years for the return of their lands.
- 2. The bill provides that PAG maintains no future plans for the development or use of this and other certain portions of parcels under their jurisdiction. Should they remain in PAG possession, there exists the notion such lands will remain idle and unused for decades to come. Therefore, in the spirit of encouraging highest and best use, it is only fit such lands be returned to original landowners to increase vulnerability to development opportunities

¹ In December 1984 the United States of America quitclaimed portions of the Apra Harbor Reservation to the Government of Guam containing certain parcels. The transfer of these parcels was slated for development purposes in support of commercial port-related activities under the guise of the Port Authority of Guam, then the Commercial Port of Guam.

and allow such owners the opportunity to finally reap the full enjoyment of their property.

3. With regards to any jurisdictional interpretation under the original intent to transfer lands to the Government of Guam by quitclaim from the federal government², we believe any possible residual jurisdiction as potentially arguable under federal authority may be moot as of the adoption of PAG's overall master plan exclude this and other contiguous properties, leaving the opportunity to exercise the authority, intention, and mandates of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission.

The Department of Land Management with the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission Board of Directors fully supports this Bill in transferring this property under the Port Authority Guam to GALC inventory.

PUBLIC HEARING TESTIMONY Bill 7-32 February 1, 2013

For the record, my name is Felix Pangelinan and I am the Deputy General Manager of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority of Guam.

On behalf of the Port and with the full support of the Board of Directors and the General Manager, I'm here today to provide oral testimony in "support" of Bill No. 7-32.

I would like to premise this testimony by noting that the Port will be also providing written testimony within the period comment following this hearing.

As the record will show, this legislation will be the 7th occurrence involving the transfer of lands under the jurisdiction of the Port to the Ancestral Lands Commission with cause to convey certain lands back to the heirs of the original land owners.

The plight of original land owners is long storied, well documented and admirable. Correspondingly, the efforts of the legislature aimed to right the wrong of the practice of land takings of past is also commendable. We all know that the political nature and sensitivity of this issue to the island's history is undeniable.

The Port acknowledges that the impacted land identified as Lot 127PI within Bill 7-32, as also the case with the six other lots conveyed back to the Ancestral Lands Commission in 2011, sat idle for nearly six decades. Every

Port master plan since 1981 did not identify the lands for any use specific to supporting Port operations.

While this may still be true today, we must further acknowledge that the physical and economic landscape and the current operational needs of the Port may soon no longer be the landscape for what the future may hold.

As you well know the Port in conjunction with the Department of Defense has broken ground on the first of several projects aimed to modernize the Public Cargo Terminal. This milestone is without precedent and is consistent with components identified within the current Port master plan. However, the approach to modernization is being scaled down such that progress towards construction is simply contingent on available funding. Notably, much of the funding slated towards modernizing the Public Cargo Terminal is from the Department of Defense.

The role properties play into the scheme of Port operations is obvious. It is the mechanism to provide revenues outside the scope of our primary function that is cargo operations.

At present, the non-operational revenue components of the Port account for 20 percent of Port revenues overall. It is substantial and critical to the daily function of the Port.

As a result of the well documented scale down in the Port modernization as compared to that as previously described in our approved master plan, and the corresponding ever changing fiscal climate considering the recent acquisition of cranes, tractors and top lifters through various loans, the Port has set a course to revisit the master plan.

This master plan reset effort is further necessitated by the need to revisit our vision for the future. We do acknowledge that the effort will conceptually set the touchtone for future development, but with it will come the need to identify funding sources to support the major undertaking beyond the scope of what is currently available today as well as the extraordinary requirements, if any, that may be needed to financially support the reset program.

So as I sit before you today, I can say that the Port does not have a need for Lot 127PI and does support the return of the Lot to the Ancestral Lands Commission as called for in Bill No. 7-32.

However, as for the other lands that remain in the inventory of the Port, we can only speculate that we will know more as we progress further down the course of the master plan reset.

One thing remains constant, and that is the Port is the economic engine for our island and with this is to also know that our needs to support this critical role will be ever changing.

Thank you for the opportunity to present my testimony on behalf of the Port, and again as noted earlier, written testimony will be provided to the Committee within the period of comment following this hearing.





II. COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS

Chairman Pangelinan: The next item on the agenda is Bill No. 7-32 (COR), An act to add a new §80105 (i) to Chapter 80 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the transfer of property under the jurisdiction of the Port Authority of Guam to the jurisdiction of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission.

The bill was introduced by Speaker Judith Won Pat. We have signed up to testify Mr. Patrick S.N. Iriarte and Mr. Felix Pangelinan from the Port Authority of Guam. Speaker Won Pat will present a synopsis of the bill.

(a) Bill Sponsor Summary

Speaker Judith Won Pat: Thank you Mr. Chairman. Last term, the 31st Guam Legislature, a bill was introduced to have certain properties return to the government that are part of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission and in turn we try to return them to the families. There is one particular family in that series of names that came out that have been located. So we are doing this piece meal. If you recall, this bill is like the bill introduced last term.

At least in testimonies that were given last time, I want the committee report to reflect that the Port Authority did say that they do support it and have the properties returned to the original landowners. Thank you.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you very much Speaker Won Pat. We will go ahead and begin with Mr. Iriarte.

(b) Testimony

1. Mr. Partrick S.N. Iriarte

Mr. Patrick S.N. Iriarte: Thank you very much and manana si yu'os ma'ase' para hamyo todus. Si yu'os ma'ase' Speaker and Vice Speaker and the rest of Guam's finest here. I would like to elongate the support of every senator here to sign off on awarding this land and blessing what we didn't know we had when it was first introduced in 2009.

We found out last year and we just want to thank you from the bottom of our hearts. I am representing my mother's interest, Rosario Wusstig San Nicolas, on this bill. Thank you.

PANEL COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you very much and Si yu'os ma'ase' Mr. Iriarte. Mr. Pangelinan?

2. Mr. Felix Pangelinan, Port Authority Guam

Mr. Felix Pangelinan: Good morning Mr. Chairman and Legislature.

[Reads testimony verbatim, see testimony on Mr. Felix Pangelinan]

PANEL COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Mr. Pangelinan, thank you and si yu'os ma'ase' for yourtestimony. We also received written testimony from the Department of Land Management. For the record they are also in support of the bill.

We also have Mr. Ricky Rapolla and Mr. Raymond Rapolla Borja who signed up and are in support of Bill 7-32 (COR). Sir, please identify yourself for the record and also present your testimony.

3. Mr. Ricky Rapolla

Mr. Ricky Rapolla Borja: For the record my name is Ricky Rapolla Borja. I am here for the bill to give back the land to the landowners. I am representing my grandmother Carlina San Nicolas Rapolla. My mother passed away a long time ago. The family had a rice plantation and all of the sudden they were taken by the military. You know how when they really want support the military here without asking for any kind of compensation or what they just went away and the military just started building on it.

We never got an update on what's happening there. I Just heard that there will be land given back to the San Nicolas family. My brother and I wanted to come here and find out about the bill. I see there is only one issue here - the big man from the Port saying that they still want to make something out of it.

I am here to get back our ancestral land from the Guam Ancestral Land Commission. To put it all into perspective to give it back to the owners. I would like to thank everybody and especially Judi Won Pat for introducing this bill because I would have never known and I am pretty sure if the family had known or put out an announcement. That's all I have to say for now until the hearing. I just want to show that I'm for the bill. When I saw that he [referring to Mr. Iriarte] was the only one it gave me more courage to come up here and talk. Thank you.

PANEL COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you very much. Senator Ysrael, please come and join the others.

4. Mr. Al Ysrael, Former Senator, 12th Guam Legislature

Mr. Al Ysrael: Thank you Mr. Chairman for the notice. I am here originally to testify for the GEDA bill but when I saw the 12 illustrious men and ladies in front of me as a captive audience I couldn't help resist making comments on the autonomous agency of the Port together with the many other autonomous agencies that the legislature has created in the past.

The autonomous agencies of Guam have become untouchable. They have become an empire and an entity on their own, responsible to no one, not even to the Legislature. How many times has the Legislature asked for documentation from the autonomous agencies? They are supposed to be semi-autonomous but they became autonomous agencies without any checks or balances.

In particular, returning this land back to the government of Guam where it naturally belongs is an excellent idea. In particular, the biggest violator is the Guam International Airport Authority. They have huge tracts of valuable land and they have become or are in the process of becoming the largest non-taxed paying landlords on the island. This is the stated goal of their Vice Chairman, Mr. Santos. He made it as a public statement last month. I thought I kept it but I couldn't find it in my records

But as an example the land under the control of this autonomous agencies do not pay gross receipts tax, do not pay income tax and do not pay real estate taxes. Therefore, they are in the position of offering land to private enterprises at the rate of, for example, four cents a square foot monthly rental. To add insult to injury this monthly rental is not paid until the 6th to the 15th year that rental payment is deferred. No one can control their actions.

PANEL COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Senator....

Mr. Al Ysrael: I know; going too far. Make this as comprehensive as possible. Include all the autonomous agencies in this comprehensive bill as a suggestion. Bring back the autonomous agencies under the control of the government of Guam.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: We have a bill to resolve some of those issues very soon.

Mr. Al Ysrael: Thank you. I couldn't resist the twelve captive audiences.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: I know. Thank you very much [former] Senator Ysrael. Si yu'os ma'ase.

Thank you very much, si yu'os ma'ase. Gentlemen thank you very much for your testimony. This concludes the testimony on Bill No. 7-32 (COR). There being no additional individuals to present any additional testimony, this Committee will continue to remain open for the acceptance of any additional information or public testimony on the bill discussed. AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §80105 (i) TO CHAPTER 80 OF TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE TRANSFER OF PROPERTY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE PORT AUTHORITY OF GUAM TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE GUAM ANCESTRAL LANDS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslatura finds that certain ancestral lands in the municipalities of Piti, Sumay and Agat were condemned under Civil Action No. 5-49 by the Naval Government of Guam creating the Apra Harbor Reservation Boundary. Eventually, the United States quitclaimed portions of the Apra Harbor Reservation to the Government of Guam in December 1984 containing certain parcels, with eventual transfer to the Commercial Port of Guam, now known as the Port Authority of Guam (PAG), for development. In formal conferences and legislative session meetings between the PAG and I Liheslatura (the Legislature), it has been stated by the PAG board, management, and personnel that the PAG does not have any future plans for the development or use of certain portions of the parcels under their jurisdiction.

Therefore, *I Liheslatura* intends to transfer such land parcels and properties to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission, so that the Guam Ancestral Lands

1 Commission can and shall proceed with the return of such land parcels and

properties to the original landowners or their estates, pursuant to the Commission's

Section 2. A new §80105(i) is hereby *added* to §80105 of Chapter 80, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

Portions of Parcel 1 South of Route 18 and contiguous to the North of Apra Harbor Parcel 6, also abutting Marine Corps Drive on the east, specifically original lot: No. 127 PI, originally owned by the Estate of Maria Salas San Nicolas, Antonia Salas San Nicolas, Carlina San Nicolas Rapolla, Joaquin S. San Nicolas, Juan S. San Nicolas, Maria S.-CI# 8383, San Nicolas, Dolores Wusstig San Nicolas, Rosario San Nicolas Iriarte, Consolacion S. San Nicolas, Ignacia San Nicolas Aflleje, Dolores C. San Nicolas, and Ana San Nicolas Sanford, in the municipality of Piti. The property shall be transferred and shall be deeded to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Act. The Guam Ancestral Lands Commission shall within one hundred eighty (180) days dispose of the land parcel and lot transferred by this Act in a manner consistent with and pursuant to its enabling legislation and its mandates. All pre-condemnation roads, easements and bull cart trails shall remain as easements for public access and utilities. The transferred property shall be zoned "A" - Agricultural zone."

Section 3. The Department of Land Management *shall* plot, plan, design, and provide within sixty (60) days of enactment an aerial overlay map delineating all roads, easements, bull-cart trails, and public access as to determine such access or easements' location in relation to the return subject Lot so that *no* Lot is landlocked. The overlay *shall* show all original Lot lines generally.

Section 4. Severability. If any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

Subject: Testimony on Bill Number 07-32

Bueñas Yan Hafa Adai: The Department has reviewed Bill Number 07-32 - An Act to Add a New §80105(i) to Chapter 80 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, Relative to the Jurisdiction of the Port Authority of Guam (PAG) to the Jurisdiction of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission. The intent of this legislative proposal is to allow the transfer of previously quitclaimed portions of the Apra Harbor Reservation to the Guam Ancestral Land Commission¹. This Bill makes particular reference to Lot 127 in the municipality of Piti. We fully support Bill 07-32 based on the following:

- 1. Lot 127 is one of various contiguous parcels that have since been returned under the auspice of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission (GALC) for the purpose of returning such lands to original landowners and/or their heirs. Consistency exists with regards to encouraging eventual transfer of ownership of lands to owners whom in turn have waited over 60 years for the return of their lands.
- 2. The bill provides that PAG maintains no future plans for the development or use of this and other certain portions of parcels under their jurisdiction. Should they remain in PAG possession, there exists the notion such lands will remain idle and unused for decades to come. Therefore, in the spirit of encouraging highest and best use, it is only fit such lands be returned to original landowners to increase vulnerability to development opportunities

¹ In December 1984 the United States of America quitclaimed portions of the Apra Harbor Reservation to the Government of Guam containing certain parcels. The transfer of these parcels was slated for development purposes in support of commercial port-related activities under the guise of the Port Authority of Guam, then the Commercial Port of Guam.

and allow such owners the opportunity to finally reap the full enjoyment of their property.

3. With regards to any jurisdictional interpretation under the original intent to transfer lands to the Government of Guam by quitclaim from the federal government², we believe any possible residual jurisdiction as potentially arguable under federal authority may be moot as of the adoption of PAG's overall master plan exclude this and other contiguous properties, leaving the opportunity to exercise the authority, intention, and mandates of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission.

The Department of Land Management with the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission Board of Directors fully supports this Bill in transferring this property under the Port Authority Guam to GALC inventory.

PUBLIC HEARING TESTIMONY Bill 7-32 February 1, 2013

For the record, my name is Felix Pangelinan and I am the Deputy General Manager of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority of Guam.

On behalf of the Port and with the full support of the Board of Directors and the General Manager, I'm here today to provide oral testimony in "support" of Bill No. 7-32.

I would like to premise this testimony by noting that the Port will be also providing written testimony within the period comment following this hearing.

As the record will show, this legislation will be the 7th occurrence involving the transfer of lands under the jurisdiction of the Port to the Ancestral Lands Commission with cause to convey certain lands back to the heirs of the original land owners.

The plight of original land owners is long storied, well documented and admirable. Correspondingly, the efforts of the legislature aimed to right the wrong of the practice of land takings of past is also commendable. We all know that the political nature and sensitivity of this issue to the island's history is undeniable.

The Port acknowledges that the impacted land identified as Lot 127PI within Bill 7-32, as also the case with the six other lots conveyed back to the Ancestral Lands Commission in 2011, sat idle for nearly six decades. Every

Port master plan since 1981 did not identify the lands for any use specific to supporting Port operations.

While this may still be true today, we must further acknowledge that the physical and economic landscape and the current operational needs of the Port may soon no longer be the landscape for what the future may hold.

As you well know the Port in conjunction with the Department of Defense has broken ground on the first of several projects aimed to modernize the Public Cargo Terminal. This milestone is without precedent and is consistent with components identified within the current Port master plan. However, the approach to modernization is being scaled down such that progress towards construction is simply contingent on available funding. Notably, much of the funding slated towards modernizing the Public Cargo Terminal is from the Department of Defense.

The role properties play into the scheme of Port operations is obvious. It is the mechanism to provide revenues outside the scope of our primary function that is cargo operations.

At present, the non-operational revenue components of the Port account for 20 percent of Port revenues overall. It is substantial and critical to the daily function of the Port.

As a result of the well documented scale down in the Port modernization as compared to that as previously described in our approved master plan, and the corresponding ever changing fiscal climate considering the recent acquisition of cranes, tractors and top lifters through various loans, the Port has set a course to revisit the master plan.

This master plan reset effort is further necessitated by the need to revisit our vision for the future. We do acknowledge that the effort will conceptually set the touchtone for future development, but with it will come the need to identify funding sources to support the major undertaking beyond the scope of what is currently available today as well as the extraordinary requirements, if any, that may be needed to financially support the reset program.

So as I sit before you today, I can say that the Port does not have a need for Lot 127PI and does support the return of the Lot to the Ancestral Lands Commission as called for in Bill No. 7-32.

However, as for the other lands that remain in the inventory of the Port, we can only speculate that we will know more as we progress further down the course of the master plan reset.

One thing remains constant, and that is the Port is the economic engine for our island and with this is to also know that our needs to support this critical role will be ever changing.

Thank you for the opportunity to present my testimony on behalf of the Port, and again as noted earlier, written testimony will be provided to the Committee within the period of comment following this hearing.





AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §80105 (i) TO CHAPTER 80 OF TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE TRANSFER OF PROPERTY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE PORT AUTHORITY OF GUAM TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE GUAM ANCESTRAL LANDS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslatura* finds that certain ancestral lands in the municipalities of *Piti*, *Sumay* and *Agat* were condemned under Civil Action No. 5-49 by the Naval Government of Guam creating the Apra Harbor Reservation Boundary. Eventually, the United States quitclaimed portions of the Apra Harbor Reservation to the Government of Guam in December 1984 containing certain parcels, with eventual transfer to the Commercial Port of Guam, now known as the Port Authority of Guam (PAG), for development. In formal conferences and legislative session meetings between the PAG and *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature), it has been stated by the PAG board, management, and personnel that the PAG *does not* have any future plans for the development or use of certain portions of the parcels under their jurisdiction.

Therefore, *I Liheslatura* intends to transfer such land parcels and properties to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission, so that the Guam Ancestral Lands

1 Commission *can and shall* proceed with the return of such land parcels and 2 properties to the original landowners or their estates, pursuant to the Commission's 3 enabling legislation and mandates.

Section 2. A new §80105(i) is hereby *added* to §80105 of Chapter 80, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

Portions of Parcel 1 South of Route 18 and contiguous to the North of Apra Harbor Parcel 6, also abutting Marine Corps Drive on the east, specifically original lot: No. 127 PI, originally owned by the Estate of Maria Salas San Nicolas, Antonia Salas San Nicolas, Carlina San Nicolas Rapolla, Joaquin S. San Nicolas, Juan S. San Nicolas, Maria S.-CI# 8383, San Nicolas, Dolores Wusstig San Nicolas, Rosario San Nicolas Iriarte, Consolacion S. San Nicolas, Ignacia San Nicolas Aflleje, Dolores C. San Nicolas, and Ana San Nicolas Sanford, in the municipality of *Piti*. property shall be transferred and shall be deeded to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Act. The Guam Ancestral Lands Commission shall within one hundred eighty (180) days dispose of the land parcel and lot transferred by this Act in a manner consistent with and pursuant to its enabling legislation and its mandates. All pre-condemnation roads, easements and bull cart trails shall remain as easements for public access and utilities. The transferred property shall be zoned "A" – Agricultural zone."

Section 3. The Department of Land Management *shall* plot, plan, design, and provide within sixty (60) days of enactment an aerial overlay map delineating all roads, easements, bull-cart trails, and public access as to determine such access or easements' location in relation to the return subject Lot so that *no* Lot is landlocked. The overlay *shall* show all original Lot lines generally.

Section 4. Severability. *If* any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity *shall* not affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
