



2 **Section 1.** A new §5132 is *added* to Part D of Article 2, Chapter 5 of Title 5,
3 Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

4 “§ 5132. **Retention of Electronic Mail Correspondences.** All
5 incoming and outgoing electronic mail (email) correspondences pertaining to
6 matters related to the procurement of goods and services as governed by this

1 Chapter *shall* be retained for a period of *not less than* five (5) years. Such
2 electronic mail (email) correspondences may be used for evidentiary purposes in
3 the appellate procedures contained in this Chapter.”

COMMENTS TO BILL 31-32(COR)**BILL NO. 31-32 IS AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §5132 TO CHAPTER 5, OF 5GCA
RELATIVE TO RETENTION OF PROCUREMENT RELATED EMAIL MESSAGES**

The Bill proposes that all incoming and outgoing electronic mail (email) correspondence pertaining to matters related to the procurement of goods and services as governed by Chapter 5 shall be retained for a period of not less five (5) years. This may entail a fiscal impact if the specific email outlets being used by Government of Guam agencies do not allow for archiving and/or if it does, for that specific period of time. This means that various email outlets being used by GovGuam agencies may need to be reconfigured to create an "Archive Folder" or "Depository site" to store such information for the proposed 5 year period. The associated cost in accomplishing this is undetermined at this time.

Committee Report Digest

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs convened a public hearing on Wednesday, March 6th, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslatura*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration was Bill No. 31-32 (COR) - V.A. Ada - An act to add a new §5132 to Chapter 5 of 5GCA relative to retention of procurement related email messages.

Public Notice Requirements

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on February 26, 2013, and March 1, 2013 via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

The public hearing was called to order at 10:05 a.m.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Vice Speaker Benjamin J.F. Cruz announced Bill No. 31-32 (COR) and deferred to Senator Anthony Ada as the main sponsor.

Senator Anthony Ada stated that Bill No. 31-32 (COR) requires all agencies to retain email related to procurement for a period of five years and that local and state governments have developed email retaining policies and that these emails are covered by state Freedom of Information Act. Senator Anthony Ada stated that in the case of procurement matters, emails may be used in civil and criminal



actions.

John Unpingco Procurement Council stated oral support for Bill No. 31-31 (COR). Mr. Unpingco stated retaining the emails is a good practice.

Senator Cruz thanked his colleagues and members of the panel for their comments then asserted that the record will be open for ten days so that residents may submit their testimonies.





9 evidentiary purposes in the appellate procedures contained in this Chapter.
