Dear Madame Speaker:

Attached is Bill No. 125-32 (COR) entitled "An Act to Appropriate the Sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars from the Guam Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Works for the Acquisition of Property for the Tiyan Parkway Project" which I have signed into law as Public Law 32-041.

Although Bill 125-32 has been signed into law, I have done so with serious reservations over the troubling language of Section 4 concerning abandoned or unused acquired land. There is no question that Section 4 will substantially result in increasing the cost of the Tiyan Parkway to the people and the Government of Guam. Giving the original landowner, from whom the Government used public funds to purchase the property in good faith, a "right" to purchase back unused portions of the property <u>for the original selling price</u> even after significant improvements are made by the Tiyan Parkway project unfairly constrains and prevents the Government from being able to offset its investment and costs.

Federal agencies who have reviewed the legislation as passed have indicated a loss of confidence in the ability of Government of Guam to complete the project as estimated, due to the fact of the increased cost associated with the language of Section 4. The loss of confidence by these federal agencies in the Government of Guam's abilities places the federal funds, which amounts to \$5.8 million dollars, "at risk" of being de-appropriated.

Lastly, the language of Section 4 runs contrary to best governmental practices. Normally if the Government of Guam were to purchase or sell real property, it would rely on appraisals of the property as a benchmark in determining the property's fair market value. The language of Section 4 prevents such practice from being implemented and is therefore detrimental to the best interests of the people.
