





1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1.** A new §79601.2 is hereby *added* to Article 6 of Chapter 79,  
3 Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, pertaining to the establishment of a War on  
4 Terror Fallen Heroes Monument in *Hagåtña*, to read as follows:

5                   **“§ 79601.2. War on Terror Fallen Heroes Monument.**

6                   Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Fallen Heroes of the  
7 Pacific Foundation (Guam) is hereby authorized to erect a memorial  
8 monument in the Skinner Plaza, *Hagåtña*, in honor of the ultimate service  
9 and sacrifices of the men and women who have served in the U S. Armed  
10 Forces in the War on Terror, to include Operation Iraqi Freedom and  
11 Operation Enduring Freedom.

12                   The Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation in the preparation and  
13 construction of the War on Terror Fallen Heroes Monument *shall* comply  
14 with the following provisions:

15                   (a)   occupy a land space *not to exceed* more than twenty feet (20’)  
16 in length and twenty feet (20’) in width within the northern segment of  
17 Skinner Plaza;


18                   (b)   submit to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* the plan and design of the  
19 monument for legislative approval by statute or resolution. The monument  
20 *shall* include, at a minimum and as provided for in this Chapter, the names  
21 of Guam’s fallen heroes and the branch served in the U.S. Armed Forces;  
22 and

23                   (c)   *shall not* hold the government of Guam liable or responsible for  
24 any expenses related to the construction and maintenance of the monument  
25 authorized herein.”



## COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

### I. OVERVIEW

**BILL NO. 120-32 (LS)** - "An act relative to honoring Guam's men and women who have courageously and selflessly served our island people and our nation in the War on Terror and who have made the ultimate sacrifice, through the establishment of a *Fallen Heroes* Monument; through adding a new subsection §79601.2 to Chapter 79, Article 6, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated," was introduced by **Senator F.B. Aguon, Jr., Senator R.J. Respicio, Senator T.C. Ada, Senator A.A. Yamashita, Ph.D., Senator V. A. Ada, Senator D.G. Rodriguez, Jr., Vice-Speaker B.J.F. Cruz, Senator T.R. Muña Barnes, and Speaker J.T. Won Pat, Ed.D.** on May 23, 2013; and was subsequently referred to the Committee on Rules; Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs; and Human & Natural Resources; and Election Reform on May 23, 2013.

Senator Rory J. Respicio, Chairperson of the Committee on Rules; Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs; and Human & Natural Resources; and Election Reform convened a public hearing on **Bill No. 120-32 (LS)** on Tuesday, June 4, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. in the Legislature's Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on the measure.

## II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

1. **Mr. Anthony G. Lukeala, Vice-President of Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation, In Support of the Bill, Provided Oral Testimony.**
2. **Mrs. Elaine Naputi, President of Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation, In Support of the Bill, Provided Oral Testimony.**

Senator Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing to order at 9:00 A.M. and deferred to Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr., as main sponsor of **Bill No. 120-32 (LS)**, to provide opening remarks.

Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. thanked Senator Respicio for expediting a hearing for Bill No. 120-32 (LS) through his committee. Senator Aguon extended his personal appreciation for his colleagues who are co-sponsors to the bill. He explained that a few weeks ago, he attended a particular ceremony of the Fallen Heroes of the Pacific members that entailed recognizing the names of the fallen heroes from Guam who have participated on the War on Terror. He noted that being in attendance at that function, brought to light some concerns, some of the members asked if it would be possible if a monument could be established or a particular area be identified for our fallen heroes. Aguon stated that this would provide for property in the *Plaza de Espana*, similar to the Purple Heart Memorial Association. He explained that recently there were two (2) soldiers from Guam who passed away and this monument is not reactionary to that, it is simply a suggestion from the Fallen Heroes of the Pacific members.

Senator Respicio called on individuals to testify on **Bill No. 120-32 (LS)**.

Mr. Anthony Lukeala, Vice President of the Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation and father of a fallen soldier, Sergeant Joshua Akoni Sablan Lukeala, provided oral testimony in support of Bill No. 120-32 (LS). He stated that this bill is very important to the community of Guam because this is for our soldiers. He has served in the community for twenty-five (25) years, especially with the JROTC Program. He highly encourages the bill be passed because it is for our soldiers. Mr. Lukeala noted that we always need to honor and remember these heroes and that this bill should be approved.

Senator Respicio thanked Mr. Lukeala for his testimony and apologized that his son took the ultimate sacrifice.

Senator pangelinan thanked Mr. Lukeala for his presence at the public hearing. He told Mr. Lukeala that his son will not be forgotten and be assured of our prayers and noted that everyday we live in a country that will remember our soldiers. The one question Senator pangelinan had was in regards to the bill placing the memorial within the *Plaza de Espana*. He noted that he thinks we get confused exactly where because on one side is Skinner Plaza where we have the Purple Heart Memorial, the statute of McArthur and on the other side is the *Plaza de Espana* with the World War II Memorial and memorial of the Insular Guard. He asked What if the memorial was placed more towards the area where the Purple Heart Memorial is? The Skinner Plaza versus the *Plaza de Espana*. He asked Mr. Lukeala if that would that area be okay in terms of honoring fallen heroes? So it would be more of a "Heroes Plaza" instead of separating them.

Mr. Lukeala noted that Senator pangelinan was LSrect. He said that it is an honor to have our fallen soldiers alongside the Purple Heart Association because Purple Heart Association are the wounded soldiers. He stated that his son's name has yet to be posted on that wall.

Senator Aguon stated that Senator pangelinan had the appropriate idea to have the Fallen Heroes Memorial near the Purple Heart Memorial. He stated that he did consider that as an option but the only issue was the construction of the Guam Museum and wether in fact there is ample space adjacent to the Purple Heart Monument. Senator Aguon noted that if it is the desire of the members of this body, to identify property there, then he certainly does not have an issue with that. He stated the end goal is to have the families have a monument that would honor their loved ones for their service.

Senator Respicio stated that this committee is amenable, so is the sponsor as to how our community can honor our fallen soldiers. His understanding is if there is space next to the Purple Heart Memorial, they will work around it. Because of the recent legislative action, the Legislature turned over the Skinner Plaza over to the Administration for purposes of constructing the museum. Senator Respicio noted that certainly they can do this by law and be guided by Fallen Heroes of the Pacific organization.

Mrs. Elaine Naputi, President of the Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation, provided oral testimony in support of Bill No. 120-32 (LS). She is the mother of a fallen soldier, Specialist Richard DeGracia Naputi from Talofofu. On behalf of the families of the fallen soldiers, she stated that they support this bill. Mrs. Naputi noted that they are very happy for the Legislature to come up with something like this. She noted that with a permanent monument like this, she is sure the fallen soldiers will be happy that they will not be forgotten.



Senator Respicio thanked Mrs. Naputi and stated they are grateful for her and her family and continues to pray for what their families have to go through to fully accept and understand this great loss. He asked her if she is in agreement so far that if there is space next to the Purple Heart Memorial, this is where it would go, if not, it would go near the *Plaza de Espana* next to the Cathedral.

Mrs. Naputi stated that she never really thought about the area but is okay with something like that. She focused on the just the idea of having such a monument built for our fallen soldiers, especially to be placed in a central location which would be good for everyone, especially the families.

Senator Respicio opened the floor to senators for follow-up questions.

Senator Tina Muna-Barnes thanked the panel for being there to support the Legislature's efforts to show that they will never forget our fallen soldiers.

Senator Respicio thanked the panel for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Senator Respicio then declared that **Bill No. 120-32 (LS)** was duly heard.

### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS




The author has changed the location of the *Fallen Heroes* Monument in *Hagatna* from the *Plaza de Espana* to the Skinner Plaza.






**COMMENTS TO BILL 120-32(LS)**

BILL NO. 130-32 IS AN ACT TO RELATIVE TO HONORING GUAM'S MEN AND WOMEN WHO HAVE COURAGEOUSLY AND SELFLESSLY SERVED OUR ISLAND PEOPLE AND OUR NATION IN THE WAR ON TERROR AND WHO HAVE MADE THE ULTIMATE SACRIFICE, THROUGH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A *FALLEN HEROES* MONUMENT; THROUGH ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION §79601.2 TO CHAPTER 79, ARTICLE 6, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED

The Bill proposes that the Monument occupy a land space not to exceed more than twenty (20) feet (20') in length and twenty feet (20') in width within the Plaza de Espana. Per discussion with the President, Mr. Joseph Artero-Cameron, Dept. of Chamorro Affairs, he clarified that after a recent meeting with Senator Frank Aguon, Jr., the place will be amended to Skinner Plaza. In addition, he clarified that there would be no-cost to the Government of Guam for the construction and maintenance of the Monument since this will be 100% covered by the "Fallen Heroes of Pacific Foundation." Only the "space" is being requested. No additional information is provided on the plan, design and estimated construction cost at this time.




1            **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2            Section 1. A new §79601.2 is hereby added to Chapter 79, Article 6, Title  
3 21, Guam Code Annotated, pertaining to the establishment of a War on Terror  
4 Fallen Heroes Monument in Hagatna, to read as follows:

5            **“§ 79601.2. War on Terror Fallen Heroes Monument.**

6            The Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation (Guam) is hereby authorized to  
7 erect a memorial monument in the Plaza De Espana, Hagatna, in honor of the  
8 ultimate service and sacrifices of the men and women who have served in the U. S.  
9 Armed Forces in the War on Terror, to include Operation Iraqi Freedom and  
10 Operation Enduring Freedom.

11            The Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation in the preparation and  
12 construction of the War on Terror Fallen Heroes Monument shall comply with the  
13 following provisions:

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1           (a)    Occupy a land space not to exceed more than twenty feet (20') in  
2 length and twenty feet (20') in width within the Plaza de Espana;

3           (b)    Submit to I Liheslaturan Guåhan the plan and design of the monument  
4 for legislative approval by statute or resolution. The monument shall include, at a  
5 minimum and as provided for in this Chapter, the names of Guam's fallen heroes  
6 and the branch served in the U. S. Armed Forces; and

7           (c)    Shall not hold the Government of Guam liable or responsible for any  
8 expenses related to the construction and maintenance of the monument authorized  
9 herein.”
