AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (c) TO § 6206, TO *AMEND* SUBSECTION (a) OF § 6210, AND TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (c) TO § 6210 OF ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 6; TO *AMEND* SUBSECTION (b) OF § 6401 OF ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 6; AND TO *AMEND* SUBSECTION (d) OF § 10102 AND § 10113 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 10, ALL OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; AND TO *AMEND* § 1820 OF ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 18 OF TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROHIBITING THE SEALING OF SETTLEMENTS OF CLAIMS AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

1 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
2 advocates for an open and transparent government and desires to enhance
3 accountability in public departments, agencies, branches, and corporations.

4 Currently, there is *no* provision in statute requiring open and transparent
5 settlements for civil action suits or other disputes concerning public departments,
6 agencies, branches, corporations and funds. Without such a statute to allow for the
7 public to review the government's actions in all settlements, the government will
8 never truly be open and accountable.

9 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that good public policy allows all settlements
10 are accessible for public review. Full disclosure of decisions made by elected or
11 appointed public officials, on behalf of the government of Guam, with individuals,
12 private businesses or other governments provides for review and scrutiny of such
13 decisions. By enacting a policy establishing full disclosure, public officials and the
14 government of Guam are more accountable in aligning settlements with the
15 public's interest, as well as building a climate of public trust.

16 Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to prohibit the sealing of
17 settlements concerning public departments, agencies, branches, corporations and
18 funds by adding and amending current laws relative to the procedures for filing
19 claims and actions to ensure that settlement of claims on behalf of the government
20 of Guam *shall* be open to public review.

21 **Section 2.** A new §6206(c) is hereby *added* to Article 2 of Chapter 6, Title
22 5, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

23 “(c) Settlement of any claims concerning the government of Guam
24 *shall not* be sealed and *shall* be open to public inspection. The Attorney
25 General or the attorney for the agency *shall* send a copy of each settlement
26 to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* within five (5) days of approval by
27 *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan.*”

1 **Section 3.** §6210(a) is hereby *amended* and a new §6210(c) is hereby
2 *added* to Article 2 of Chapter 6, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated, to read:

3 “(a) Subject to the approval of the court in which the case is
4 pending, the Attorney General is authorized to settle a suit at any time
5 before final judgment; *provided*, that if government funds are to be
6 paid in excess of the balance in the Government Claims Fund, an
7 appropriation for that purpose or authorization to transfer resources of
8 the government for that purpose *shall* have been previously authorized
9 by law.”

10 “(c) Settlement of any claims concerning the government of
11 Guam *shall not* be sealed and *shall* be open for public inspection. A
12 copy of each settlement *shall* be sent to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan*
13 *Guåhan*.”

14 **Section 4.** §6401(b) of Article 4 of Chapter 6, Title 5, Guam Code
15 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:,

16 “(b) Reports by the Attorney General. Upon the settlement of
17 any claim by the Attorney General, or final judgment in any action
18 under this Chapter, the Attorney General *shall* designate which line
19 agency incurred the liability, which requires payment, and whether the
20 liability arose under tort or contract. A report of settlements or
21 judgements in any action under this Chapter *shall* be made to the
22 Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* every thirty (30) days.”

23 **Section 5.** §10102(d) of Article 1 of Chapter 10, Title 5, Guam Code
24 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

25 “(d) *Public records* includes any writing containing
26 information relating to the conduct of the public’s business prepared,
27 owned, used, or retained by any state or local agency in any format,

1 including electronic format; and any out-of-court settlement records.”

2 **Section 6.** §10113 of Article 1 of Chapter 10, Title 5, Guam Code
3 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

4 **“§ 10113. Judicial Records.**

5 The provisions of this Chapter *shall not* be deemed in any manner to
6 affect the status of judicial records as it existed immediately prior to the
7 effective date of this Section, nor to affect the rights of litigants, including
8 parties to administrative proceedings, under the laws of discovery of Guam,
9 nor to limit or impair any rights of discovery in a criminal case. The sealing
10 of settlement documents in cases involving the government of Guam is
11 prohibited.”

12 **Section 7.** §1820 of Article 2 of Chapter 18, Title 1, Guam Code
13 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

14 **“§ 1820. Legislative Approval of Settlements.**

15 *No* office, department, instrumentality, agency, institution, board,
16 bureau, commission, council, authority, committee of territorial government,
17 or branch of the government of Guam may enter into any consent decree,
18 stipulated order or other settlement agreement with any party seeking a
19 claim against the government of Guam that requires the payment of cash,
20 financing, or future financing by the government of Guam without the
21 approval of *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature), or a specific appropriation for
22 that claim. Any proposed settlement agreement, *supra*, that requires
23 legislative appropriation or authorization, by an office, department,
24 instrumentality, agency, institution, board, bureau, commission, council,
25 authority or branch, purporting a consent decree, stipulated order or other
26 settlement with the government of Guam *shall* be transmitted to *I*
27 *Liheslatura* which, by statute, may amend, approve, or disapprove the plan

1 or the action taken within forty-five (45) days, or said plan or action *shall* be
2 deemed disapproved. This Section *shall not* apply to claims against the
3 government arising from the provisions of the Government Claims Act
4 (Chapter 6, 5GCA), the actions authorized by public law of the Civil Service
5 Commission, or other settlements expressly authorized by public law. *No*
6 settlement in legal proceedings or threatened legal proceedings concerning
7 the government of Guam *shall* be sealed from public review.”

8 **Section 8. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or its application to
9 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
10 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be
11 given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the
12 provisions of the Act are severable.

Dear Senator Pangelinan:

The following information relates to Bill 133-32. It is intended to provide you with information about how payments for government tort claims and judgments are being handled.

The attached schedule was prepared by the Department of Administration (DOA). The schedule shows payments made from the fiscal year 2013 appropriation of \$100,000 to the claims fund. It also shows the claims currently pending payment from future appropriations. Any pending settlements are not final until funds sufficient to make payment have been appropriated to the claims fund. Once funds are sufficient to pay a claim or part of a claim, a partial release or a full release is signed by the claimant and the claim is paid.

The government claims fund has received an annual appropriation of approximately \$100,000 for many years. Although this amount may have been adequate in the past, it has not been sufficient to cover claims and judgments in recent years.

Serious injuries to multiple parties can result in damage claims above \$100,000 for a single case. Courts, naturally, encourage the settlement of cases and do not hesitate to hold the government liable for all injuries, including pain and suffering, that result from the negligent acts of government employees.

As can be seen on the last page of DOA's schedule, after the \$100,000 appropriation for the current fiscal year was exhausted, a balance of \$132,358.16 remained. The 2013 fiscal year appropriation had to be used to pay claims from fiscal years 2011 and 2012. For the past few years, the new and outstanding claims and judgments for one fiscal year have been more than

\$100,000. Consequently, the unpaid balance at the end of a fiscal year has been increasing. Thus, when the driver of a government vehicle negligently causes damage to another vehicle, the claimant must wait over one year before he or she receives a payment for the damages to the claimant's vehicle.

We hope this information is helpful. Please let us know if you have any questions.

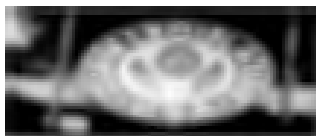

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*

advocates for an open and transparent government and desires to enhance accountability in public departments, agencies, branches, and corporations.

Currently, there is no provision in statute requiring open and transparent settlements for civil action suits or other disputes concerning public departments, agencies, branches, corporations and funds. Without such a statute to allow for the public to review the government's actions in all settlements, the government will never truly be open and accountable.

1 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that good public policy allows all
2 settlements are accessible for public review. Full disclosure of decisions
3 made by elected or appointed public officials on behalf of the government
4 of Guam with individuals, private business or other governments provides
5 for review and scrutiny of such decisions. By enacting a policy establishing
6 full disclosure, public officials and the government of Guam are more
7 accountable in aligning settlements with the public's interest, as well as
8 building a climate of public trust.

9 Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to prohibit the sealing of
10 settlements concerning public departments, agencies, branches,
11 corporations and funds by adding and amending current laws relative to
12 the procedures for filing claims and actions to ensure that settlement of
13 claims on behalf of the government of Guam shall be open to public
14 review.

15 **Section 2.** §6206(c) is hereby added to Title 5 Guam Code Annotated,
16 Chapter 6, Article 2 to read:

17 **"§ 6206. Settlement of Claim Before Action.**

18 (c) Settlement of any claims concerning government of Guam
19 shall not be sealed and shall be open to public inspection. The
20 Attorney General or the attorney for the agency shall send a copy of

1 each settlement to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* within five (5)
2 days of approval by *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*. "

3 **Section 3.** §6210(a) is hereby amended and §6210(c) is hereby added

5 **"§ 6210. Settlement of Suit.**

6 (a) Subject to the approval of the court in which the case is
7 pending, the Attorney General is authorized to settle a suit at any

9 be paid in excess of the balance in the government claims fund, that
10 appropriation for that purpose or authorization to transfer resources
11 of the government have been authorized by law.

12 (b) In the case of autonomous agencies, the attorney
13 representing such agency is authorized to settle a suit against the
14 agency he represents subject to the approval of the governing board

5 liability arose under tort or contract. A report of settlements or
6 judgements in any action under this Chapter shall be made to the

9 Annotated, Chapter 10, Article 1 to read:

10 **“§ 10102. Definitions.**

11 (d) *Public records* includes any writing containing information
12 relating to the conduct of the public’s business prepared, owned,
13 used, ~~retained~~ or any out-of-court settlement records by any state or
14 local agency in any format, including electronic format.”

15 **Section 6.** §10113 is hereby amended to Title 5 Guam Code

16 Annotated, Chapter 10, Article 1 to read:

17 **“§10113. Judicial Records.**

18 The provisions of this Chapter shall *not* be deemed in any
19 manner to affect the status of judicial records as it existed
20 immediately prior to the effective date of this Section, not to affect the
21 rights of litigants, including parties to administrative proceedings,

1 under the laws of discovery of Guam, nor to limit or impair any
2 rights of discovery in a criminal case. The sealing of settlement
3 documents in cases involving government of Guam is prohibited.”

6 **“§ 1820. Legislative Approval of Settlements.**

7 No office, department, instrumentality, agency, institution,
8 board, bureau, commission, council, authority, committee of
9 territorial government *or* branch, of the government of Guam may
10 enter into any consent decree, stipulated order *or* other settlement
11 agreement with any party seeking a claim against the government of
12 Guam, that requires the payment of cash, financing, *or* future
13 financing by the government of Guam without the approval of *I*
14 *Liheslatura* [the Legislature] *or* specific appropriation for that claim.
15 Any proposed settlement agreement, *supra*, that requires legislative
16 appropriation *or* authorization, by an Office, Department,
17 Instrumentality, Agency, Institution, Board, Bureau, Commission,
18 Council, Authority *or* Branch, purporting a consent decree, stipulated
19 order *or* other settlement with the government of Guam *shall* be
20 transmitted to *I Liheslatura* which, by statute, may amend, approve, *or*
21 disapprove the plan *or* the action taken within forty-five (45) days *or*

1 said plan *or* action *shall* be deemed disapproved. This Section *shall not*
2 apply to claims against the government arising from the provisions of
