BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §3102.1 of Chapter 3, Article 1, Title 16, Guam Code
Annotated, pertaining to Drivers License Fees Waived for Veterans, is hereby
amended to read as follows:

“§ 3102.1. Waiver of Fees for Veterans.

1 The fee for the issuance of a motor vehicle driver's license, to include
2 all classes and endorsements, is waived for Veterans of the United States
3 Armed Forces. Veterans include persons who served in the Guam Combat
4 Patrol, the United States Navy Insular Forces, Guam Militia or Civilian
5 Scouts, Philippines Scouts and the United States Armed Services.

6 Any person listed above and whose character of military service was
7 honorable as verified by the applicant's Report of Transfer or Discharge
8 (DD Form 214), or Military Identification Card Department of Defense
9 Form 2 (Retired), or other accepted forms used to verify membership in the
10 organization listed and certified by the government of Guam Office of
11 Veterans Affairs (OVA) may apply to the License Division of the
12 Department of Revenue and Taxation for a Driver's License. Certification
13 by the OVA will be based only upon records they have available. When
14 requested by the OVA, the Department of Revenue and Taxation shall
15 provide a listing of Veterans granted fee waivers."

16 **Section 2. Effective Date.** The provisions contained herein *shall* be
17 effective upon enactment of this Act.

“§ 3102.1. Waiver of Fees for Veterans.

The fee for the issuance of a motor vehicle driver's license, to include all
classes and endorsements, ~~an operator's, chauffeur's, or motorcycle license~~ is
waived for Veterans of the United States Armed Forces. Veterans include persons
who served in the Guam Combat Patrol, the United States Navy Insular Forces,
Guam Militia or Civilian Scouts, Philippines Scouts and the United States Armed
Services.

Any person listed above and whose character of military service was
honorable as verified by the applicant's Report of Transfer or Discharge (DD Form

to the License Division of the Department of Revenue and Taxation for a Driver's

What more must the government of Guam do to help the island's military veterans?

As chairman of the Committee on the Guam U.S. Military Relocation, Homeland Security, Veterans Affairs and Judiciary of the Mina Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guahan, I would like to highlight several of the benefits and services that have been extended to island veterans by their local government, and further enumerate several proposals that have been introduced that continue to recognize the unique service that many of our men and women in the U.S. Armed Forces have provided in the defense and preservation of freedom.

The government of Guam presently provides the following services, benefits or programs for Guam's veterans:

- Veterans license plates;
- Waiver of license plate fees for 100-percent disabled American veteran or legal guardian;
- Waiver of driver's license fees (operator, chauffeur or motorcycle), process eased through the provision of official documentation directly to Revenue and Taxation;
- Waiver of motor vehicle registration for 100-percent disabled American veteran and individual unemployable;
- Preferential points for government of Guam employment;
- Waiver of fees for special Gold Star License Plates for parents, widow/widower of deceased veteran; and
- Burial spaces at the Veterans Cemetery.

In addition, your leaders in the Guam Legislature continue to consider additional services or benefits for our veterans to include the following:

- The establishment of a Fallen Heroes Monument for the War on Terror (to be entertained by Liheslaturan Guahan in the upcoming session);
- The creation of a Guam Veterans Registry, which will directly assist in further advocating for much-needed local and federal services and programs for our veterans;
- The eventual establishment of the "Sengsong Betaranun Guahan" or Guam Veterans Village, which will serve as a one-stop service center for veterans and a permanent home for the Office of Veterans Affairs; and
- The expansion of the waiver of the driver's license fee, to be applicable to all classes and endorsements.

The committee is in the process of finalizing the aforementioned information and much more, in both a written brochure format and an electronic format, which will be made available to all of Guam's veterans through my office.

As can be noted with the information provided above, your government has worked diligently over the years in providing our veterans with much needed services and benefits. These efforts will continue in the years ahead, as I can attest to the tremendous support for veterans by members of I Liheslaturan Guahan, who acknowledge and appreciate the special service provided by Guam's veterans--retired, active duty, or reserve.

I would like to close by mentioning ongoing efforts by the committee in bringing together primary veteran service providers in our community. This includes our local veteran organizations, our partners in the federal government (Guam Vet Center, Veterans Benefits Office, Outpatient Clinic, and others) and nonprofit organizations, i.e. WestCare.

It is through collaboration and understanding the needs of our veterans that we can altogether work toward ensuring the proper services and programs are identified and made available for our veterans.

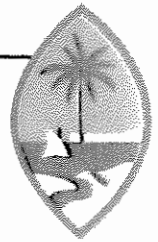

COMMENTS on Bill No: 143-32(COR)

Bill 143-32(COR) proposes to extend established §3102.1 of Chapter 3, Article 1, Title 16 GCA applicability to waive *all* drivers license fees of *all* classes and endorsements for veterans. Current law waives said fees for Operator, Chauffeur, and Motorcycle licenses. Thusly, adoption of Bill No. 143-32(COR) will equate to a further reduction in revenues.

Per a statistics report from Department of Revenue & Taxation (DRT), Motor Vehicle Section (MV): "Listing of selected Veteran Records with endorsement of C, D, E or F" for the period January 2012 to June 22, 2013 indicates that there is a total of **672** licenses comprised of class A, B and F licenses obtained by veterans within this time period. All licenses illustrated in the report are currently mandated for fee waivers. 89 of the licenses were obtained at a 3-year renewal (\$25) and 583 were obtained at the 5-year renewal (\$45) for a grand (actual) total of:
 $89 \times \$25 + 583 \times \$45 = \underline{\$28,460}$.

In consideration of the foregoing data, the anticipated fiscal impact from reduction of revenues and the increase of fee waivers from proposed legislation would = **\$82** (3yr renewal of each license not covered + annual Taxi License fee), *or*, **\$142** (5yr renewal of each license not covered + annual Taxi License fee).

Utilizing at least 10% of the total number of license holders ($672 \times 10\% = 67$), the following formulation would indicate an estimated depiction of the potential fiscal impact of proposed law:

3-year renewals $\rightarrow \$7 + \$75 = \$82 \rightarrow 67 \times \$82 = \$5,494$

5-year renewals $\rightarrow \$7 + \$135 = \$142 \rightarrow 67 \times \$142 = \$9,514$

Fiscal impact may not be readily observed to the General Fund, where said fees are deposited, but consequently affected through this Bill by the forfeiture of license fees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §3102.1 of Chapter 3, Article 1, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, pertaining to Drivers License Fees Waived for Veterans, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§ 3102.1. Waiver of Fees for Veterans.

The fee for the issuance of a motor vehicle driver's license, to include all classes and endorsements, ~~an operator's, chauffeur's, or motorcycle license~~ is waived for Veterans of the United States Armed Forces. Veterans include persons who served in the Guam Combat Patrol, the United States Navy Insular Forces, Guam Militia or Civilian Scouts, Philippines Scouts and the United States Armed Services.

Any person listed above and whose character of military service was honorable as verified by the applicant's Report of Transfer or Discharge (DD Form 214), or Military Identification Card Department of Defense Form 2 (Retired), or other accepted forms used to verify membership in the organization listed and certified by the government of Guam Office of Veterans Affairs (OVA) may apply to the License Division of the Department of Revenue and Taxation for a Driver's

1 License. Certification by the OVA will be based only upon records they have
2 available. When requested by the OVA, the Department of Revenue and Taxation
3 shall provide a listing of Veterans granted fee waivers.”

4 **Section 2. Effective Date.**

5 The provisions contained herein shall be effective upon enactment of
6 this Act.
