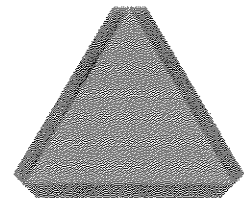
Dear Madame Speaker:

Attached is Bill No. 154-32 (COR), entitled, "**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 7160(F) OF CHAPTER 7, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING FROM VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEE REQUIREMENTS CERTAIN MOTORIZED UTILITY VEHICLES OPERATED BY GUAM MAYORS IN ACCORDANCE WITH, AND IN FURTHERANCE OF THEIR STATUTORILY PRESCRIBED DUTY TO OVERSEE, COORDINATE AND OTHERWISE UNDERTAKE THE BEAUTIFICATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THEIR VILLAGES,**" which lapsed into law as **Public Law 32-102.**

It is agreed with *I Liheslatura* that on occasion it is necessary and in the public interest that village Mayors be able to operate certain motorized utility vehicles upon public roadways, including the routed roads. In doing so, however, the safety of the Mayors and of the traveling public must be made a priority.

Therefore, after consultation with the Federal Highway Administration, it is strongly recommended that *I Liheslatura* consider amending P.L. 32-102 or the Vehicle Code of Guam to provide that slow-moving vehicles such as motorized utility vehicles which travel at a speed of less than 30 m.p.h. display a slow-moving vehicle emblem such as shown below when traveling along the public roadways, including the routed roads. The display of the slow-moving vehicle emblem is a legal requirement in most states, as it serves to protect the public and save lives.

As depicted here, the slow-moving vehicle emblem is a fluorescent red-orange triangle surrounded by a reflective dark-red border. The emblem is displayed in a position visible from the rear for a distance of at least 600 feet when illuminated by the low-beam headlights of a following automobile.







DUTY TO OVERSEE, COORDINATE AND OTHERWISE  
UNDERTAKE THE BEAUTIFICATION AND MAINTENANCE  
OF THEIR VILLAGES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds  
3 that pursuant to §§ 40112 and 40113 of Division 4, Chapter 40, Title 5, Guam

1 Code Annotated, Guam Mayors are responsible for general minor repair and  
2 maintenance work, including, but *not* limited to, cleaning, painting, plumbing,  
3 planting, collecting and transporting trash and debris, and other similar tasks  
4 incident to the general upkeep, beautification and maintenance of their respective  
5 villages.

6 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that in performing these duties the  
7 Mayors and/or their respective staff regularly operate certain motorized utility  
8 vehicles, such as multifunctional utility/logistics and equipment vehicles (mules),  
9 gator recreational utility vehicles (gators), and riding mowers.

10 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that while the Mayors' operation of  
11 these vehicles is primarily limited to the shoulders of public roadways, *I*  
12 *Liheslatura* recognizes that said operation involves moving onto the travelled  
13 portion of public roadways on certain occasions, such as where passage on the  
14 shoulder of a road is impossible or otherwise unsafe. Therefore, *I Liheslaturan*  
15 *Guåhan* deems it in the public interest that the village Mayors be able to operate  
16 these vehicles upon public roadways under certain circumstances, and, toward this  
17 end, that said vehicles, when operated as prescribed by this Act, be exempted from  
18 the requirements of Guam's vehicle registration law.

19 **Section 2.** A new paragraph (f) is *added* to §7160 of Chapter 7, Title 16,  
20 Guam Code Annotated, to exempt from vehicle registration fee requirements  
21 certain motorized utility vehicles operated by village Mayors under certain  
22 conditions, to read:

23 “(f) A “motorized utility vehicle” may operate in accordance with,  
24 and in furtherance of, legitimate Mayoral duties. Mayors, Vice-Mayors,  
25 and/or their respective staff may operate motorized utility vehicles, such as  
26 mules, gators, golf carts, and riding mowers on non-routed public roadways,  
27 so long as said vehicles are permanently marked with the Mayor's official

1 logo of that municipality, where (1) passage on the shoulder of a roadway is  
2 impossible or otherwise unsafe, and (2) the operator of said vehicle is  
3 engaged in the performance of Mayoral duties as prescribed by Title 5 GCA  
4 §40101 *et seq.*, and is otherwise acting in accordance with Guam law;  
5 provided, that the motorized utility vehicle may operate on routed roadways  
6 for the purpose of crossing to get from one non-routed roadway to another.  
7 For the purposes of this Subsection, a “motorized utility vehicle” is any  
8 motorized vehicle primarily manufactured for off-roadway use, which is  
9 sixty-three inches (63”) or less in width, has an unladen dry weight of one  
10 thousand eight hundred fifty pounds (1,850 lbs) or less, travels on less than  
11 six (6) wheels, and can travel up to maximum speeds of 20 miles per hour.  
12 The registration fee of subject utility vehicles, that are the property of the  
13 Mayoral offices, *shall* be waived.”

14 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This provisions contained herein *shall* take  
15 effect upon enactment of this Act.

## COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

### I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 154-32 (COR) was introduced on July 17, 2013 by Senators Tina R. Muna Barnes and Brant T. McCreadie. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on July 17, 2013.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on September 16, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill 154-32 (COR). The hearing was adjourned at 2:23 p.m.

### II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

*\*NOTE: due to technical problems with the audio and visual services, parts of the hearing were not available to the Committee for record purposes\**

**Senator Tina Muna Barnes** stated that the bill was introduced at the recommendation of the Mayors' Council of Guam. She said that in the past, mayors and vice mayors knew that they were not able to move unregistered

and unlicensed vehicles through routed and secondary roads because the Council did not have a memorandum of agreement with the Guam Police Department; the fear was that they may be cited. She further went on to state that allowing the use of smaller utility vehicles is more cost effective for the various mayoral offices and will allow them to carry out their collective missions and mandates.

**Senator Frank Aguon, Jr.** commended the Mayors' Council of Guam for addressing this issue. He stated that allowing access to village roadways for larger vehicles, including construction equipment, during peak traffic time periods should be an avenue that they consider pursuing as long as it doesn't negatively impact the regular flow of traffic or cause undue congestion for drivers. He supports the bill and again commended the manner in which the issue was brought to the attention of the Legislature.

**Senator Tommy Morrison** asked if the legislation would affect federal grants.

**Mr. Carl Dominguez** stated that he didn't know the answer at that moment. He stated that Guam's routed roads are heavily traveled and that most drivers do not comply with the speed limit. His concern is that the utility vehicles used by the mayoral offices and the vehicle operators are at a greater risk than if they were traveling on only village roads. He reiterated that his primary concern was safety.

**Senator Morrison** commended the authors of the legislation. He stated that there needs to be data with regards to accidents involving the utility vehicles used by the mayoral offices as they would be helpful in determining if there is any potential impact to federal funding. He stated his support for the bill.

**Senator Tony Ada** asked who would be liable if the utility vehicles are involved in an accident since, as an unregistered vehicle, it would not require vehicle insurance.

**Mayor Paul McDonald** answered that the government would be liable. He further stated that the mayoral offices already drive vehicles that are unregistered.

**Mr. Dominguez** stated that it is his understanding that the government of Guam is self-insured.

**Senator Ada** asked if that covered both registered and unregistered government vehicles.

**Mr. Dominguez** stated that as long as the vehicle was owned by the government, the government would be liable.

**Senator Ada** asked if the utility vehicles being used have head lights, tail lights, and signal lights.

**Mayor McDonald** stated that they are equipped with those features.

**Senator Ada** asked why the utility vehicles cannot just be registered and be able to drive on roadways.

**Mayor McDonald** stated that is possible. He mentioned that the mayoral offices have certain protocols and procedures in place when using the utility vehicles. The use of utility vehicles for certain operational purposes would be more convenient and affordable for the mayoral offices. Mayoral offices should not be restricted from having certain vehicles travel routed roads because they want to ensure that their villages are maintained and kept clean.

**Mayor Vicente Gumataotao** stated that the government of Guam is liable for its vehicles but has no money to pay.

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas** thanked the mayors for their advocacy of the service of the people and thanked Mr. Dominguez for his advocacy for the safety of the people.

### **III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds  
3 that pursuant to §§40112-40113 of Division 4, Chapter 40, Title 5, Guam Code  
4 Annotated, Guam Mayors are responsible for general minor repair and  
5 maintenance work including but not limited to cleaning, painting, plumbing,  
6 planting, collecting and transporting trash and debris, and other similar tasks  
7 incident to the general upkeep, beautification and maintenance of their respective  
8 villages.

9           *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that in performing these duties, the  
10 Mayors and/or their respective staff regularly operate certain motorized utility  
11 vehicles such as multifunctional utility/logistics and equipment vehicles (“mules”),  
12 gator recreational utility vehicles (“gators”), and riding mowers.

1        *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that while the Mayors' operation of  
2 these vehicles is primarily limited to the shoulders of public roadways, *I*  
3 *Liheslatura* recognizes that said operation involves moving onto the travelled  
4 portion of public roadways on certain occasions such as where passage on the  
5 shoulder of a road is impossible or otherwise unsafe. Therefore, *I Liheslaturan*  
6 *Guåhan* deems it in the public interest that the village Mayors be able to operate  
7 these vehicles upon public roadways under certain circumstances, and, toward this  
8 end, that said vehicles, when operated as prescribed by this Act, be exempted from

Good afternoon, Mr. Chairman and Members of your Committee:

As the Director for the Department of Public Works as well as the Governor's Highway Safety Representative for Guam, I hereby submit my written testimony on Bill 154-32(COR) "an act to add new §7103(g) of chapter 7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, relative to exempting from vehicle registration requirements certain motorized utility vehicles operated by Guam mayors in accordance with, and in furtherance of, their statutorily prescribed duty to oversee, coordinate and otherwise undertake the beautification and maintenance of their villages."

The DPW-Office of Highway Safety functions relates to all highway safety standards established by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the Department of Transportation (DOT). The Office of Highway Safety prepares, develops and revises comprehensive plans based on an evaluation of highway safety problems within the territory to reduce traffic crashes, deaths, injuries, and property damages resulting in Guam's public roadways.

As advocates of highway traffic safety, the DPW-Office of Highway Safety has the following concerns:


1. If these vehicles were to be driven on Guam's public roadways, particularly routed roadways when passage on the shoulder of a roadway is impossible, who will be responsible in the event of a crash?
2. Are these vehicles to be exempted from seat belt use and any future citations from the Guam Police Department? The current law does not exempt these types of vehicles from seatbelt use while operating on the main highway.
3. Are these vehicles even equipped or manufactured with seat belts?

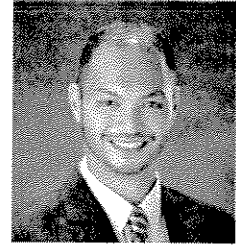

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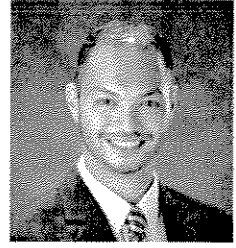

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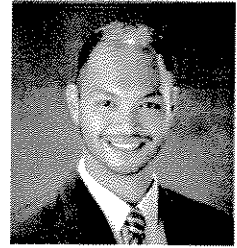

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**AN ACT TO ADD NEW §7103(g) OF CHAPTER 7, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING FROM VEHICLE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS CERTAIN MOTORIZED UTILITY VEHICLES OPERATED BY GUAM MAYORS IN ACCORDANCE WITH, AND IN FURTHERANCE OF, THEIR STATUTORILY PRESCRIBED DUTY TO OVERSEE, COORDINATE AND OTHERWISE UNDERTAKE THE BEAUTIFICATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THEIR VILLAGES.**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds  
3 that pursuant to §§40112-40113 of Division 4, Chapter 40, Title 5, Guam Code  
4 Annotated, Guam Mayors are responsible for general minor repair and  
5 maintenance work including but not limited to cleaning, painting, plumbing,  
6 planting, collecting and transporting trash and debris, and other similar tasks  
7 incident to the general upkeep, beautification and maintenance of their respective  
8 villages.

9           *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that in performing these duties, the  
10 Mayors and/or their respective staff regularly operate certain motorized utility  
11 vehicles such as multifunctional utility/logistics and equipment vehicles (“mules”),  
12 gator recreational utility vehicles (“gators”), and riding mowers.

1        *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that while the Mayors’ operation of  
2 these vehicles is primarily limited to the shoulders of public roadways, *I*  
3 *Liheslatura* recognizes that said operation involves moving onto the travelled  
4 portion of public roadways on certain occasions such as where passage on the  
5 shoulder of a road is impossible or otherwise unsafe. Therefore, *I Liheslaturan*  
6 *Guåhan* deems it in the public interest that the village Mayors be able to operate  
7 these vehicles upon public roadways under certain circumstances, and, toward this  
8 end, that said vehicles, when operated as prescribed by this Act, be exempted from  
9 the requirements of Guam’s vehicle registration law.

10        **Section 2.** Section 7103 of Chapter 7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is  
11 hereby *amended* by *adding* new subsection (g) to exempt from vehicle registration  
12 requirements certain motorized utility vehicles operated by village Mayors under  
13 certain conditions:

14                “(g) Operating a “motorized utility vehicle” in accordance with, and in  
15 furtherance of, legitimate Mayoral duties. Mayors, Vice-Mayors, and/or  
16 their respective staff may operate unregistered motorized utility vehicles  
17 such as mules, gators, golf carts, and riding mowers on public roadways  
18 where (1) passage on the shoulder of a roadway is impossible or otherwise  
19 unsafe, and (2) the operator of said vehicle is engaged in the performance of  
20 Mayoral duties prescribed by 5 GCA §40101 *et seq.*, and is otherwise acting  
21 in accordance with Guam law. For purposes of this section, a “motorized  
22 utility vehicle” is any motorized vehicle primarily manufactured for off-  
23 roadway use, which is sixty-three inches (63”) or less in width, has an  
24 unladen dry weight of one thousand eight hundred fifty pounds (1,850 lbs) or  
25 less, and travels on less than six (6) wheels.

26        **Section 3. Effective Date.** This provisions contained herein shall take  
27 effect immediately upon enactment of this Act.
