II. COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS

Vice Chairman Cruz: The Committee on Appropriations, Public Debt, Legal Affairs, Retirement, Public Parks, Recreation, Historic Preservation and Land will now come to order. The public hearing and notices for this public hearing were published in the Marianas Variety and were circulated to the appropriate press for both the 5-day and the 48 hour notice.

We have five bills on the agenda today and unfortunately the Chairman is not present this morning and so I, as Vice Chairman has been asked to conduct this hearing. We will begin this morning with Bill 251, introduced by Senator Dennis Rodriguez and I will ask Senator Rodriguez to make a sponsor statement.

Bill Sponsor Summary:

Senator Dennis Rodriguez: Thank you very much Mr. Chair, Hafa Adai and good morning. Bill 251 is basically similar to what we entertained, the Guam Legislature a few days ago. It is a requirement of the lender, the Bank of Guam in this case for us to include this language in current statute where we already waived sovereign immunity. What this bill does is include language that would include attorney's fees and other related costs as it pertains to any suit that is brought against the government to enforce the agreement, which is the loan in this case. This is for the Guam Legislature. This particular loan negotiations have been completed and the only thing that is outstanding is this language so that the lender, as well as the government with the Attorney General is satisfied with what we are doing here. Thank you, Mr. Chair.

Testimonies

Vice Chairman Cruz: Thank you. I will read the official title. It's an Act to Amend Public Law 32-67 Relative to the Waiver of Sovereign Immunity on a loan previously authorized for the Guam Legislature. The Executive Director of the Guam Legislature, Mr. Arriola and Mr. Quinata from the Guam Preservation Trust. Please proceed Mr. Arriola.

Mr. Vince Arriola: Thank you, Mr. Chair. My name is Vince Arriola, the Executive Director of the Guam Legislature. Good morning, Mr. Chair and members of the Committee.

I just have a few comments. As you know, we passed and enacted Public Law 32-67 that gives us the authority approves the loan terms with the lender, the Bank of Guam. Since then, we have been in negotiations, in contact and in meetings with the bank, the bank's legal counsel, the AG's office, GEDA in trying to get the bank documents finalized. The one sticking point is basically before you. We are now at the one yard line. We need approval of this proposed bill that would broaden the sovereign immunity that is contained in Public Law 32-67 as Senator Rodriguez had mentioned. It's similar to the GMH loan that was entertained last week and the Port loan that is about to be heard, I believe right after us.

We tried valiantly for the last 2-3 months to work with the AG, but they were firm in their position that this is the language that they want if in fact we are going to sign the documents that the bank wanted, as well. The bank took it back and forth with the their legal counsel, their loan committee and they were firm, as well. We are now in a position where we need a revision in the law. We ask for your support. Joe Quinata here from the Guam Preservation Trust is ready. The building plans have been set. The bids are ready and once this is passed and enacted into law, we should close the loan within a week to ten days. Nothing longer. Thank you very much, Mr. Chairman.

Vice Chairman Cruz: Thank you Mr. Arriola.

Mr. Joe Quinata: Mr. Chairman and Senators, good morning. I would like to ready my testimony.

Vice Chairman Cruz: Thank you very much. On behalf of myself and I am sure my colleagues I want to thank and congratulate and commend both of you for the efforts that you've undertaken to make sure that the renovations at the Plaza de Espana turned out as beautifully as they did. I am sorry I wasn't here for the ribbon cutting but I drove by yesterday and was very impressed and I would like to thank both of you for the work that you did on that effort. I know there was a lot of work that had to be done to make sure that you maintained the historical significance in that area and I want to commend both of you for all that hard work.

I really look forward to us moving this bill through and finally getting the Guam Legislature back in place. As you know I have been traveling and I have been in numerous cities where the restoration and the efforts to make sure that they maintain the historical significance of historical buildings is paramount. It is important for their tourism. It underscores the importance of their tourism. Besides [inaudible] what you are proposing, it also is necessary because that eye sore across the Cathedral and the beautifully renovated Plaza and the soon to be built museum, it is going to continue to be an eye sore unless we can get this going and the renovations completed.

Thank you and the historic preservation for all the work that you did. The plans that have been shown to us of that building are absolutely beautiful. I remember it as a child. I am glad that it is finally going to be re-built and will be able to have sessions and hearings in that building.

Senator Rory Respicio: Thank you very much, Mr. Vice Speaker. Mr. Chairman, I just wanted to echo your sentiments and also thank Senator Rodriguez for introducing this bill. As you stated and as we all know this is what we hope is the final hurdle to getting the construction started. I want to state for the record, Mr. Chairman that the partnership with the Historic Preservation Trust and our Executive Director has been paramount and has been excellent and strong. Together with the Guam Economic Development Authority in securing this financing through the Bank of Guam, which brings the Bank of Guam as another partner to recognize in this venture.

Mr. Chairman, just so you know and the people know certainly Speaker Won Pat herself and Senator Barnes who I see as my legislative bosses here have been asking on a daily basis what is the status of restoring the old Congress building. As you know, we even had to go above and beyond to tell this administration that if they want the Legislature to release title to Skinner Plaza then we put a reversionary clause in that they have to make the Historic Preservation Trust whole again by returning the money that it took over the years, the cash that it took over the years and certainly through your efforts and efforts by Speaker Ben and the HOT Bonds, that is how we are able to replenish those cash.

I just want to say and back these promises up that if this bill passes and the Governor signs it that the bid package is ready to go. Can you just say that again for the record? You don't need to be under oath, because I know it's going to happen.

Mr. Joe Quinata: We've been waiting for the bid advertisements and the bid package has been ready. We have done the review twice with the reviewing agency because it's been a while to make sure that these agencies are aware of this project.

Senator Rory Respicio: In other words, it's a multi-prong approach so we weren't waiting for the financing to be secured and your ready to go to the next phase.

Mr. Joe Quinata: As soon as we secure the funds, the advertisement will be out.

Senator Rory Respicio: That's why I want to congratulate both of you and all of you in your efforts to include that when we restore the old Congress building. Certainly it's going to be cost savings to the people of Guam and that we would not be renting this building or saving the rental on ten office spaces so whatever we decide to do, there is certainly a significant savings in the end. Thank you Senator and colleagues for this bill.

Vice Chairman Cruz: Thank you very much, both of you and again thank your staffs for all the effort they have undertaken over the last years.

Thank you very much for your testimony. This concludes the testimony on Bill No. 251. There being no additional individuals to present any additional testimony, this Committee will continue to remain open for the acceptance of any additional information or public testimony on the bill discussed. 2 **Section 1.** Section 12 of Public Law 32-67 is hereby amended to read as
