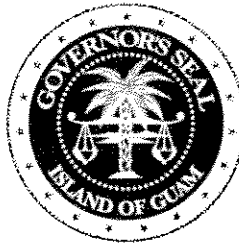





Section 1. §10238 of Article 2, Chapter 10 of Title 12, Guam Code
Annotated, as *added* by Public Law 32-042, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

“§ 10238. **Sovereign Immunity Waived.** Notwithstanding any
substantive or procedural provision of Chapter 6 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated,
the Authority *shall not* be entitled to immunity from any suit or action in contract
on any indebtedness authorized by this Article. For the purposes of this Article

1 *only*, immunity is also waived as to the award of attorney fees and related costs in
2 connection with any suit brought to enforce any right or obligation given under this
3 Article, in connection with the enforcement of the terms of any agreement of
4 indenture that arises directly from the issuance of bonds or indebtedness authorized
5 by the Article.

6 Should any suit or action arise or be initiated to enforce any of the terms of
7 any agreement, indenture, or pledge of revenues, concerning the indebtedness
8 authorized under this Article, any judgement therein *shall* be paid solely from the
9 revenues of the Authority, and at no time shall any other property be subject to
10 foreclosure or recourse to satisfy any suit or action authorized by this Article or
11 judgment therein.”

Sponsor Statement

Senator Dennis Rodriguez: Thank you Mr. Vice Chairman. This bill is similar to the bill we just heard for the Guam Legislature (referencing Bill 251-32). This bill deals with the Port Authority of Guam. The difference here is the PUC tariff increase; the proposal is still with the PUC. The Attorney General has not signed off on these loan documents that the Legislature previously authorize. But once all the procedures are done and it goes to the Attorney General's Office this language would also satisfy the requirements of the banks/lenders as well as the interpretation of the Attorney General with regard to Sovereign Immunity. Now it would also cover attorney's costs and related costs related to any suit that is brought against the Port for the enforcement of the loan. Thank you Very much Mr. Vice Chair.

Vice Chair BJ Cruz: Thank you Senator Rodriguez. I note that I have signed up Mr. Pangelinan to testify.

Testimonies

Mr. Felix Pangelinan: Thank you very much Mr. vice Chair and members of the committee. I believe Director Arriola and Mr. Quinata (referencing Bill 251-32) has made our point because we are in the same boat.

[Read from his written testimony verbatim.]

Vice Chair BJ Cruz: Thank you very much. Any questions? Senator Duenas?

Senator Chris Duenas: Thank you Felix - just a real quick question because I want to put something on the record here. Did you receive any outside testimony from any attorney, any entities or any financial institution with regard to this proposal?

Mr. Felix Pangelinan: They are all in agreement, in writing 'nd'. We have gotten calls for support of the bill.

Senator Chris Duenas: Mr. Chairman, first of all, I want to thank the main sponsor of this legislation for including me as a co-sponsor. We had a very spirited session a few days ago and that was the anticipation of many spirited conversations. This would be a standard and uniform agreement with regard to this requirement (that the bank put forward). I just wanted to include that as part of the public hearing, realizing and recognizing while there was a lot of back and forth, and a very spirited discussion, it really was more of a procedural matter the financial institution were requiring. Banks had required this and I believe that many financing schemes would require this going forward. Thank you for the opportunity to have these measures move forward. I think Mr. Pangelinan you are probably in the same position as the Hospital needing this money almost immediately to move forward with your improvements. Correct?

Mr. Felix Pangelinan: Yes sir.

Please accept the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Port Authority of Guam's testimony in support of Bill 252-32 (COR), relative to an additional waiver of sovereign immunity on the approved Port Authority of Guam (PAG) - Bank of Guam (BOG) loan. PAG is grateful for the Legislature's previous approval of PAG's request to waive sovereign immunity allowing for the Ten Million Dollar (\$10,000,000) loan in question to proceed (currently before the Public Utilities Commission).

The loan documents PAG and BOG executed and the Legislature approved contained the following language:


15. Fees and Expenses. The Authority shall pay on demand the reasonable fees and out-of-pocket expenses of outside legal counsel for the Lender incurred in connection with the making of the Loans and the preparation, execution, delivery, filing and recording of this agreement and other documents to be made, executed and delivered in connection with the Loans. The Authority shall pay all other expenses of the Lender, including reasonable attorney's fees, in connection with the administration of the Loans, and all costs and expenses, if any, in connection with the enforcement of this Loan Agreement, the Notes, or the Pledges, including reasonable attorney's fees.

Subsequent to the Legislature's waiver of sovereign immunity in suit for the applicable indebtedness and award of attorneys fees, the Attorney General of Guam opined that such waiver would not cover language similar to that agreed to between PAG and BOG and approved by the Legislature. In furtherance of PAG's pledge above and in good

faith, PAG supports the proposal to include the award of costs in the Legislature's earlier waiver of sovereign immunity. BOG has informed PAG that BOG does not intend to back out of the current PAG-BOG agreement and therefore the inclusion of the additional waiver of sovereign immunity should not affect the status of the loan approval before the Public Utilities Commission (PUC).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §10238 of Article 2, Chapter 10, Title 12 Guam Code Annotated,
as amended by Public Law 32-042 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§10238. Sovereign Immunity Waived. Notwithstanding any
substantive or procedural provision of Chapter 6 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated,
the Authority *shall not* be entitled to immunity from any suit or action in contract
on any indebtedness authorized by this Article. For the purposes of this Article
only, immunity is also waived as to the award of attorney fees and related costs in
connection with any suit brought to enforce any right or obligation given under this
Article, or in connection with the enforcement of the terms of any agreement of
indenture that arises directly from the issuance of bonds or indebtedness authorized
by this Article.

Should any suit or action arise or be initiated to enforce any of the terms of
any agreement, indenture, or pledge of revenues, concerning the indebtedness

1 authorized under this Article, any judgement therein *shall* be paid solely from the
2 revenues of the Authority, and at no time shall any other property be subject to
3 foreclosure or recourse to satisfy any suit or action authorized by this Article or

5 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
6 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity
7 shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given
8 effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions
9 of this Act are severable.
