





testimony but we will conduct this public hearing and hold it for the record and we will also give an opportunity for the sponsor to issue a statement on the bill.

(a) Bill Sponsor Summary

Senator Tony Ada: Thank you Mr. Chairman. Mr. Chairman, two federal statutes; The Credit Card Accountability Responsibility and Disclosure (CARD) Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-24) and the Eco-Gift Card Act (Public Law 111-209) created new requirements for electronic gift cards. Under these laws electronic gift cards must have minimum expiration date of five years and generally prohibits companies from charging dormancy fees for not using the card for long periods of time.

Bill 70-32 does two main things, (1) it recognizes that the federal law applies to Guam and (2) makes the same policies of the federal law apply to paper gift certificates. This bill will create a minimum five year expiration date for paper gift certificates and the bill will provide for certain exemptions such as promotional gift certificates that were not bought with cash and phone cards.

The reasoning behind Bill 70-32, the sellers of gift certificates give their money up front yet many of them put a 3-month expiration date on them or even sooner and after 3-months the buyer is left with a useless piece of paper. That's just not right. Bill 70-32 seeks to rectify this inequity. I think there are just a couple of companies that are on island, if you do go buy paper gift certificates, you'll notice the expiration date sometimes just says open or none for the date. With the paper gift certificates we just want to makes sure that all those that buy gift certificates, the redeemer has time to use it and that the money is just not left out there and they are left with a worthless piece of paper. Thank you Mr. Chair.

PANEL COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Chairman Vicente (ben) C. Pangelinan: Thank you very much Senator Ada. Just curious, what if the gift certificate cost \$100 and the guy waits four years to redeem it and the service is now being assessed at \$200. Does he get to redeem it at \$200 or redeem the \$100 and pay the additional \$100?

Senator Tony Ada: That's the way it would be. The gift certificate is valued at what it was purchased for. If it were purchased for \$100 and four years later that service is now increased to \$200 then they would have to pay the difference because that gift certificate would now hold the value of \$100.

Chairman Vicente (ben) C. Pangelinan: Ok. Great. Thank you.

Senator Tony Ada: Thank you Mr. Chair.

(b) Testimony

1. Mr. Manny Duenas - President, Fisherman's Cooperative Association

Mr. Duenas: My name is Manny Duenas, President of the Fishermen's Cooperative Association and here to make comments on Bill 70. Senator Ada, I appreciate the bill but as an operator of a small business, 5 years is a long time. I support the bill, but I think for paper consideration, I year is sufficient. The other concern I have is we have a lot of gift certificates as a donation. So, putting us in a financial bind to hold that thing for 5 years is kind of difficult. I have not read the legislation completely. I am just saying on the surface what I have read. I was not prepared to testify, so I am just raising the points.

PANEL COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Senator Tony Ada: To answer Mr. Duenas' question; for promotional or gift certificates that you gave in donation, that is exempted from the bill.

Chairman Vicente (ben) C. Pangelinan: This concludes the testimony on Bill No. 70-32. There being no additional individuals to present any additional testimony, this Committee will continue to remain open for the acceptance of any additional information or public testimony on the bill discussed. 



- 8 §32801. Applicability of Federal Law. TITLE IV of the Credit Card

- 11 Cards sold by merchants doing business on Guam. Such federal law is in addition

- "Gift Card/ Gift Certificate/ Store Gift Card" are defined by 12 CFR 205.
- 2 "Paper Gift Card/ Gift Certificate/ Store Gift Card" means any Gift Card/Gift

- 4 and issued in exchange for monetary consideration when the certificate, card, or
