



Section 1(f) of the Bill proposes that violations of paragraphs (a), (b), (c) or (d) of Section 1 are "civil violations" punishable by a fine of One Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for subsequent offenses. This could entail possible revenues to the Court and/or government of Guam when an employer(s) is found guilty by a the Court of such violation and is imposed the proposed fine. Thus, the annual revenue impact will be determined by the number of violators found guilty and fine assessed per year. Because of the lack of historical data, the potential revenue impact is undetermined at this time.
