



The only exception made for this Section is that juvenile sex offenders who are adjudicated in the Family Court, and who meet the definition under §89.01(g)(2)(B), shall be exempted from the public web site disclosure and shall be placed on a private, non-public database, wherein such registration information will only be made available to the National Sex Offender Registry ("NSOR") to be placed in the national (non-public) databases of sex offender information, to law enforcement and supervision agencies, and to registration authorities in other jurisdiction."
