





Enactment of the proposed legislation entails an additional impact on the General Fund of \$292,800 for drug and alcohol treatment services and emergency youth shelter for homeless, runaway, and abused youth. It is noted that the following FY2014 appropriations under P.L. 32-068 are made: \$860,683 to Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center (GBHWC) to fund programs contracted out to non-governmental organizations for drug and alcohol detoxification, rehabilitation, and prevention services (Ch. III, Pt. III, §4); and \$321,556 to Department of Youth Affairs (DYA) to fund programs contracted out to non-government organizations for services to youths who are runaways, homeless, or victims of abuse (Ch. V, §1(q)(4)). Of these appropriations, Sanctuary, Inc. as of 4/21/14, has received under GBHWC, payments of \$173,332.63 with outstanding encumbrances of \$13,333.33; and under DYA, has received payments of \$174,510.73 with outstanding encumbrances of \$114.889.27. The bill language identifies that §11 is to be added to Ch. XI of P.L. 32-068, however, it should be changed to read §13 instead, since §11 and §12 already exist under Chapter XI.



Håfa adai! I wish to respectfully request your consideration of an emergency declaration relative to Bill No. 315-32 (LS), pursuant to §2103, Title 2 of the Guam Code Annotated, for the purpose of consideration by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

Sanctuary, Incorporated operates the regions only accredited adolescent drug and alcohol rehabilitation program. The cost to operate this program at full capacity, serving more than 300 youth and their families seeking drug and alcohol services annually, is estimated at more than \$622,000; a shortfall of about \$132,000.

The COED emergency shelter is a 24 hour facility that offers emergency shelter to youth between the ages of 12 and 17 who are homeless, runaway, victims of abuse, and those needing respite due to family and household dynamics. The cost to operate this facility, inclusive of case management, therapy, and life skills instruction, is \$547,880 annually. This is a difference of \$160,800.

Without the additional \$292,800.00, the drug and alcohol treatment program has had to turn away approximately 200 youth, and the COED emergency shelter is under threat of closure. Sanctuary, Inc. has also had to lay off six employees.

I kindly request your favorable consideration.



Dear Speaker Won Pat,

Håfa adai! I wish to respectfully request your consideration of an emergency declaration relative to Bill No. 315-32 (LS), pursuant to §2103, Title 2 of the Guam Code Annotated, for the purpose of consideration by I Liheslaturan Guåhan.

Sanctuary, Incorporated operates the regions only accredited adolescent drug and alcohol rehabilitation program. The cost to operate this program at full capacity, serving more than 300 youth and their families seeking drug and alcohol services annually, is estimated at more than \$622,000; a shortfall of about \$132,000.

The COED emergency shelter is a 24 hour facility that offers emergency shelter to youth between the ages of 12 and 17 who are homeless, runaway, victims of abuse, and those needing respite due to family and household dynamics. The cost to operate this facility, inclusive of case management, therapy, and life skills instruction, is \$547,880 annually. This is a difference of \$160,800.

Without the additional \$292,800.00, the drug and alcohol treatment program has had to turn away approximately 200 youth, and the COED emergency shelter is under threat of closure. Sanctuary, Inc. has also had to lay off six employees.

"Section 11. Detoxification, rehabilitative and preventative Two Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Eight Hundred services. Dollars (\$292,800) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to Sanctuary, Inc., to fund programs for drug and alcohol treatment services and emergency youth shelter for homeless, runaway, and abused youth."
