



**AN ACT TO *AMEND* SUBSECTION (a) OF § 80105,  
CHAPTER 80, DIVISION 4 OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE  
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING FOR A  
REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GUAM MEMORIAL  
HOSPITAL VOLUNTEERS ASSOCIATION TO SERVE  
AS AN EX-OFFICIO MEMBER OF THE GUAM  
MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY BOARD OF  
TRUSTEES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** The Guam Memorial  
3 Hospital Volunteers Association (GMHVA) has historically played an important

1 role in providing invaluable services and needed resources to the Guam Memorial  
2 Hospital Authority (GMHA). Established in 1965 as a non-profit corporation for  
3 the primary purpose of supporting Guam's only public hospital, the GMHVA has  
4 raised and donated in excess of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) in funds and  
5 equipment. For over forty-nine years, the dedicated members of the GMHVA have  
6 consistently demonstrated their unwavering commitment to promoting and  
7 enhancing the services and resources of the Guam Memorial Hospital. In times of  
8 need, they could always be counted on in being at the forefront and doing whatever  
9 it takes to help address the needs and challenges being encountered by GMHA.

10 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that it is appropriate that a representative of the  
11 Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association should be a full member of the  
12 Guam Memorial Hospital Authority Board of Trustees.

13 **Section 2.** Subsection (a) of § 80105 [Board of Trustees] of Chapter 80,  
14 Division 4, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

15 “(a) The governance and control of the Guam Memorial Hospital  
16 Authority are vested in a Board of Trustees (Board). The Board *shall* be  
17 composed of ten (10) members: four (4) members representing the general  
18 public, who *shall* possess a background and experience in healthcare,  
19 management, finance or any other business-related field; one (1) member  
20 representing the Allied Health Professions; two (2) members representing  
21 the Guam Nursing Association; and two (2) members representing the Guam  
22 Medical Community, appointed by *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* as provided  
23 herein, with the advice and consent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. In addition,  
24 one (1) member who *shall* be the President, or designee, of the Guam  
25 Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association, who *shall* be an ex-officio  
26 member with full participatory rights and privileges, but without the right of  
27 voting. The GMH Volunteers Association President or designee *shall* have

1           been a member of the GMH Volunteers Association for a minimum of five  
2           (5) years prior to assuming a position on the Board.”

3           **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provision of this law or its application to  
4 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such  
5 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this law which can be  
6 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the  
7 provisions of this law are severable.

8           **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon its  
9 enactment.




