COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

Bill No. 292-32 (COR), As Amended by the Committee: An act to add a new subsection §4104.2 to §4104 of Chapter 4, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated relative to the Proof of Eligibility for Veterans Preference Credit.

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 292-32 (COR) was introduced by Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. on March 14, 2014, and subsequently referred to the Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs on March 18, 2014.

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs convened a public hearing on Wednesday, April 23, 2014, at 2:00PM in the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room.

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on April 16, 2014, and April 21, 2014, via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairperson Benjamin J.F. Cruz announced Bill No. 292-32 (COR) and invited Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. to provide his sponsor statement.

Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. thanked Chairperson Cruz and proceeded to provide his statement:

"This issue was brought to the attention of my office in regards to the requirement of the definition of Veteran's Preference and how it is applied to the Government of Guam workforce. In the Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations (GARR), it states that a person must have completed one hundred

eighty (180) consecutive days of service in the armed forces. In many instances, especially with the [National] Guard or Army Reserves, they are given many exercises and training where they serve less than one hundred eighty (180) consecutive days. The term 'consecutive' will read as 'cumulative'. It would retain the spirit of the original piece of legislation, but add the cumulative effect of one hundred eighty (180) days. Mr. Vice Speaker, an individual who is in the reserve component brought this to us. I want to thank him for bringing this to our attention. I asked him to testify and provide written testimony, however, he is at a training right now. I ask my colleagues to give this serious consideration. Thank you, Mr. Chairman."

Chairperson Cruz thanked Senator Aguon and added that he hoped to receive clarification on the cumulative number of days considered as time in service.

Senator Aguon repeated his previous remark that "it is a cumulative totaling to one hundred eighty (180) days."

Chairperson Cruz responded that the issue would be discussed in Committee.

Senator Aguon thanked Chairperson Cruz.

Chairperson Cruz stated that the Committee will consider Bill No. 292-32 (COR) to be heard, and that it will continue receiving public testimony.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Non-substantive changes were made to increase the measure's clarity and render its form consistent with legislative practice.

On the recommendation of the author, the Committee Amends Bill No. 292-32 (COR) in the following manner:

"4104.2 Proof of Eligibility for Veteran's Preference Credit. Persons claiming veteran's status must submit their DD Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge, DD Form 2 (Military Identification Card), Certificate of Service, Department of Veteran's Affairs (DVA) Veterans Identification Card, or other official verification from the Department of Defense (DOD). A person must have completed at least 180 cumulative days of service in the Armed Forces of the United States and must have received other than a dishonorable discharge from such service to be eligible for veteran's preference."

The above referenced revisions were made to include additional documentation that will, in the opinion of the Committee, provide the proof required by the proposed statute and increase convenience to the affected veteran.

Under the current policies of the Dept. of Administration's Rules and Regulations, *Section 4.303 Proof of Eligibility for Veteran's Preference Credit*, it states that to be eligible for veteran's preference a person must have served at least 180 consecutive active duty days with the Armed Forces of the United States.

Though it is commendable and well deserving of this recognition for their volunteerism and sacrifice to maintain readiness outside the theater of war, war veterans, without consideration of how many days they served consecutively, must also be given this same recognition. In many instances, guardsmen, especially those serving with the Air Guard and Reserves, are voluntarily sent off in support of a war operation without exceeding or meeting the 180 consecutive day requirement. In many other cases, guardsmen often volunteer for numerous other deployments in support of the war, but still do not qualify for veteran's preference because of the 180 day requirement.

Currently, veteran's preference points are offered to war veterans who are employed by the federal government without any consideration of how many consecutive active duty days they served. This should be the policy of the Government of Guam.

This injustice needs to be addressed and I hope and trust that you'll consider this important issue and hopefully make CHANGE. Once again senator, keep up the good work and continue to support our veterans. Hope to hear from you soon.

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 292-32 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 231-32(COR) is an Act to add a *new* subsection §4104.2 of Chapter 4, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated relative to the proof of eligibility for Veterans Preference Credit.

The Bill proposes that persons claiming veteran's status must submit their DD Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge. The Bill stipulates that in order for a person to receive veteran's preference, they must have accumulated at least 180 days of service in the Armed Forces of the United States without receiving a dishonorable discharge.

The intent of the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.



The Bureau requests that Bill No. 292-32 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 231-32(COR) is an Act to add a *new* subsection §4104.2 of Chapter 4, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated relative to the proof of eligibility for Veterans Preference Credit.

The Bill proposes that persons claiming veteran's status must submit their DD Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge. The Bill stipulates that in order for a person to receive veteran's preference, they must have accumulated at least 180 days of service in the Armed Forces of the United States without receiving a dishonorable discharge.

The intent of the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION §4104.2 TO §4104 OF CHAPTER 4, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY FOR VETERANS PREFERENCE CREDIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A *new* subsection §4104.2 is hereby *added* to §4104 of Chapter 4, Title 4 of Guam Code Annotated to read:

4 "4104.2 Proof of Eligibility for Veteran's Preference
5 Credit. Persons claiming veteran's status must submit their DD
6 Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or
7 Discharge. A person must have completed at least 180 cumulative
8 days of service in the Armed Forces of the United States and must
9 have received other than a dishonorable discharge from such
10 service to be eligible for veteran's preference."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall become immediately effective upon enactment.

Section 3. Severability. If any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall *not* affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
