

I. COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS

Acting Chairman BJ Cruz: Thank you for your presence this morning for the Committee on Appropriations, Public Debt, Legal Affairs, Retirement, Public Parks,

Recreation, Historic Preservation and Land public hearing. We are here this morning to hear Bill 324-32. I have Jimmy Teria and Dr. John Taitano. Dr. Taitano, I understand you are on call so you will go first.

Testimonies

Dr. John Taitano: Thank you for allowing us to do the first presentation. Speaking on behalf of the Young Men's League of Guam, I am the Vice President; the President is presently off-island.

Acting Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Thank you very much, Doctor. Mr. Teria.

Mr. Jimmy Teria: Good afternoon, my name is Jimmy Teria I am the secretary for the Young Men's League of Guahan and we have a resolution here signed by the Board of Directors.

[Read resolution #2014-002 verbatim. See attached]

Acting Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Thank you Mr. Teria.

Mr. Andrew Laguana: I have just a brief comment. I am a member of the Board of Directors for the Young Men's League of Guam. I read a little bit of history about the YMLG and it was not a cakewalk. There was a lot of resistance by the then American Governor and the local clergy. It took the initiatives of all these gentlemen before us to write a letter to the United States President to get it approved. It is with that we totally support this bill. I think it is fitting to name something with permanence like a park in the city of Hagåtña, the capital city. It is fitting we name something after YMLG. That is my comment. Thank you.

Acting Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Thank you very much. I think our local historian may want to add to that. Dr. Bevaqua.

Dr. Michael Lujan Bevaqua: (translated from Chamorro to English). 1 will attempt this in Chamorro because I really like the intentions of this gathering. I know there is difficulty in discussions of this nature especially if done in the Chamorro language but we persist and continue to try.

It is a challenge for our young people to know our language and it is important that they hear it all around them. For myself, once a month, every month I go to the clubhouse to immerse myself in the language and that is what I like. I support this bill because this group has historical significant. When you look back at the list of past members, there were Governors, Commissioners, Senators, people of leadership positions. I have told my students that if they want to learn, this is one of the clubs you can learn from. For me the most important aspect of this club is its early history. This is the significance because

the resistance to form the group was a challenge for our forefathers; they fought against the Navy and the church. But in their minds they saw it as important to have a meeting place to be Chamorro person, a place where they can gather and be proud and use the language, a place where they can celebrate being Chamorro. If you look back in history, the colonizers whether they were Spanish, Americans or Japanese, they tried to remove the language and the culture from the Chamorro people. They (Colonizers) instead tried to tell us who we were, that they were lower class. They did not want them to proliferate language and culture; the colonizers told them that their language and culture were of no service and of no value. But these men band together and told them, no we need to create a space to honor and celebrate who we are as a Chamorro people.

I can't believe that it has been a hundred years since the formation of the club. It is important that we mark a territory to recognize the efforts put forth by the early forefathers and a park is a good way to do it. Thank you for this opportunity to speak.

Acting Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Thank you very much Dr. Bevaqua. Senator Tom Ada, do you have a question?

Senator Tom Ada: I just have two questions: Can you clarify if it is west Hagåtña Park or east? The bill says east but you said west. I asked someone where this park is and someone pointed to that (west). So, this is west then.

Mr. Andrew Laguana: When you are facing the ocean, it is left from the hot dog stand. So whatever that is, that's what it is.

Senator Tom Ada: I guess the dividing line is the Agana Stadium. Anything to the right of that is east, anything to the left of that is west. We just need to be more clear as to which park we are talking about because this leads me to my second question. In so naming this area, this park, after the Inetnon Lalåhen Guahån, will the organization take on the responsibility of maintaining the park?

Because right now the Department of Parks and Recreation is maintaining it and now we are going to put the organization's name and I am sure you want to see this as a shinning landmark. So, is it reasonable to assume that the organization will assume the responsibility of maintaining the park; cutting the grass maybe short of re-building of the pavilion.

Mr. Andrew Laguana: That question was raised by the members, but the idea was just for the renaming of the park and maybe the painting of the shelters. As far as the maintenance, the daily or weekly maintenance of the park will still remain with Department of Parks and Recreation.

Senator Tom Ada: That is really important to know because the bill does not say that. Maybe the organization is thinking, hey, we don't want that responsibility we just want the fame and glory. We may need to make that more clear.

Acting Chairman Benjamin Cruz: We also need to clarify what might be a misconception by the director. The Director, Mr. Blas, submitted testimony and in part he says "the YMLG is also a supporter in DPR and are in the process of formalizing public-partnership for the adoption of maintenance of the East Hagatna Beach." So we will have to clarify that.

Mr. Andrew Laguana: Maybe in addition to that, a map showing where it is instead of a description of east or west.

Acting Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Depending on whether you are facing it.

Mr. Andrew Laguana. It could be north or south.

Senator Tom Ada: I think on the western side, there are three pavilions.

Mr. Andrew Laguana: Yes, I think I will clarify that.

Acting Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Senator Tina Muna Barnes, do you have a question?

Senator Tina Muna-Barnes: I too read the report from Mr. Blas from the Department of Parks and Recreations for both Bill 295 and 324. My question to the members: was the Mayor of Hagåtña included in this process? Did he give his support or intention to support or was he made aware that this change?

Mr. Andrew Laguana: Ah, no.

Senator Tina Muna-Barnes: I support this bill, but think it is very important that we involve the Mayor. Usually when a bill of this magnitude is introduced, the Municipal Planning Council (MPC) - in this case the renaming of a park or area - and within the jurisdiction of that mayor's village and then the MPC gets involved and they send a resolution to this body in support. I know that it is in support, but I just don't see it here. I guess we will just ask the committee to double check.

Mr. Andrew Laguana: Okay, we will put that on the list.

Senator Tina Muna-Barnes: Please. Saina ma'ase.

Acting Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Thank you very much, Si Yu'os Ma'ase.

This concludes the testimony on Bill No. 324-32. There being no additional individuals to present any additional testimony, this Committee will continue to remain open for the acceptance of any additional information or public testimony on the bill discussed. Diabetes forecast points to rise in cases | Pacific forum leaders asked not to

one years from now, the incidence of diabetes among Fiji's population could be 50 percent, equating to a ratio of one diabetic patient for every healthy person.

This was revealed by medical officer-in-charge and chair of Diabetes Fiji for the Central and Eastern Division, Dr. Lisi Piniasi.

He made the assertion white commenting on predictions made by international medical experts that by 2035, the total number of people suffering

For Fiji, the percentage of diabetics could increase from 30 percent to 50 percent, "So instead of a 3-to-1 ratio, we are looking at a 1-to-1 ratio for diabetes patients," she said.

She said about \$548 billion was spent globally last year to combat diabetes.

Finiasi said local authorities were looking at people between the ages of 40 and 59 years, who were dying prematurely.

"About 5.1 million deaths were recorded globally last year. This means that every six seconds, a person dies from diabetes

Affordability

According to Finiasi, the increase in these diseases was because of the affordability of sugar-sweetened beverages and food items.

"We have to make the healthier choice the more affordable choice

"People don't die of diabetes - they die from the complica-tions of diabetes. We should try to control and prevent these diseases in the first place.

PNG among top 10 countries of smokers

PORT MORESBY (Loop PNG) - Papua New Guinea is one of the top 10 countries in the world with the highest smoking prevalence.

According to the World Health Organization percent of adult men and 27 percent of women in PNG are current smokers.

WHO country representative Dr. Pieter Van Maaren says this is a major epidemic that requires urgent and swift

"The harm caused by tobacco is not just a set of numbers. It is the loss of mothers, fathers. sisters and brothers. It is the struggle of lifelong treatment for chronic illnesses. It is the trial that families must bear as breadwinners are unable to work

And it is at the cost to the nation as a whole, as it tries to meet the heavy burden that the tobacco industry places on the economy," Maaren said.

He urged the government to support the proposed amendments to the Tobacco Control Act and to increase taxes on tobacco products which will discourage people from smoking and stay healthy



AN ACT TO ADD A §849.8 TO CHAPTER 1 OF ARTICLE 1 OF TITLE 1 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO NAMING THE EAST AGANA BEACH PARK TO THE "I INETNON LALAHEN GUAHAN-YMLG CENTENNIAL BEACH PARK" IN HONOR OF THE YOUNG MEN'S LEAGUE OF GUAM ORGANIZATION.



BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §849.8 is hereby added to Chapter 8, Article 1 of Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:
- "§849.8. I Inetnon Lalåhen Guåhan Young Men's League of Guam
 Centennial Beach Park
 - (a) Renaming of the East Agana Beach Park located in the municipality of Hågatña, Territory of Guam shall hereafter be known as the "I Inetnon Lalåhen Guåhan-Young Men's League of Guam Centennial Beach Park."
 - (b) Name Change, Statutory References. Any provisions in the statutes referencing the East Agana Beach Park are amended to read: "I Inetnon Lalåhen Guåhan- Young Men's League of Guam Centennial Beach Park."
- 12 (c) Signs and Formal Designation of "I Inetnon Lalåhen Guåhan- Young 13 Men's League of Guam Centennial Beach Park." Subject to the approval of the 14 Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Young Men's League of

- 1 Guam Organization shall cause to be erected appropriate nameplates or signs
- 2 designating the East Agana Beach Park as the "I Inetnon Lalåhen Guåhan- Young
- 3 Men's League of Guam Centennial Beach Park."
- Further, at such ceremony as I Maga'lahen Guåhan [the Governor], the
- 5 Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Mayor of Hågatña, the
- 6 members of the Hågatña Municipal Planning Council deem appropriate, said "I
- 7 Inetnon Lalåhen Guåhan- Young Men's League of Guam Centennial Beach Park"
- 8 shall be officially named, and a plaque bearing the name, picture and brief history
- 9 of the contributions of "I Inetnon Lalahen Guahan- Young Men's League of Guam
- 10 Centennial Beach Park" shall be affixed within a suitable spot on or above the
- 11 designated area."
