BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslatura finds that Public
- 3 Law 35-77 amended § 715(1)(13) of Chapter 7, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, to
- 4 require the one hundred eighty (180) instructional days, or its equivalence of nine

- hundred (900) instructional hours per school year, for both elementary and
 secondary schools.
 I Liheslatura recognizes that because of the closure of Guam's public schools
- due to the COVID-19 outbreak, the Guam Department of Education may be unable to provide the one hundred eighty (180) instructional days, or its equivalence of nine hundred (900) instructional hours, as required by Public Law 35-77.
- Thus, it is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to create an exemption from the one hundred eighty (180) instructional days, or its equivalence of nine hundred (900) instructional hours, requirement for School Year 2019-2020.
- Section 2. § 715(l)(13) of Chapter 7, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

- "(13) at least one hundred eighty (180) instructional days, or its equivalence, including make-up hours each school year with school years ending no later than thirty (30) days following the end of the calendared school year; provided, that the Guam Department of Education is exempt from the requirements of this § 715(l)(13) for School Year 2019-2020."
- **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
