R.J. RESPICIO AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF 23 ADDITIONAL REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE EXPIRATION OF ANY PART OF THE BUSH TAX

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: 1

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guahan 2 finds that it is clear that, through inaction or deliberate policy of the federal 3 government, some or part of the "Bush Tax Cuts" will expire in 2013 with a 4 resulting increase in federal income tax revenue. This will impact on 5 Government of Guam revenues as well, because most of the government's 6 7 revenues are raised from the Territorial Income Tax, which "mirrors" federal income tax law. Consequently, any changes to the federal income 8 tax will automatically change the Territorial Income Tax with an attendant 9 increase in revenues. Such changes were not factored into the revenue 10 estimate for the Government of Guam's 2013 Budget as enacted by Public 11 Law 31-233. Any additional revenue to come from the expiration of all or 12 part of the Bush Tax Cuts is therefore unappropriated. I Liheslatura finds 13 that these additional revenues should be utilized in support of education of 14

our island's children and should therefore be appropriated to the
Department of Education.

Section 2. Within thirty (30) days of the enactment of this Act, the 3 Director of Revenue and Taxation shall provide a written estimate of the 4 additional revenue that would accrue to the Government of Guam as a 5 result of the expiration of any part of the Bush Tax Cuts which were 6 originally enacted as part of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief 7 Reconciliation Act of 2001 (EGTRRA) and extended by the Jobs and 8 Growth Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2003 (JGTRRA) and the Tax Relief, 9 Unemployment Insurance Reauthorization, and Job Creation Act of 2010. 10 This estimate shall be transmitted upon completion immediately to I 11 Liheslaturan Guahan. 12

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Education those additional revenues for FY 2013 as a result of the expiration of all or part of the Bush Tax Cuts as determined by the Director of Revenue and Taxation in accordance of Section 2 of this Act. The Superintendent of Education is authorized to utilize this appropriation to fund school operations and school repairs and renovations as provided for by Public Law 31-229.
