## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent**: I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the projects funded and authorized pursuant to the Highway 2001 Bond 3 Construction Fund, as provided pursuant to §22427, Division 2, 5 GCA, and the 4 Highway 1985 Bond Construction Fund, as provided pursuant to §1504 of 5 GCA, 5 have been completed and that there are remaining funds available for 6 reprogramming for flood mitigation projects throughout the island. There are 7 specific areas in Barrigada, Dededo and Harmon that require immediate action. 8 The projects listed in Section 2 of this Act are areas that the Department of Public 9 Works have been made aware of their conditions and the work necessary to 10 mitigate flooding. I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the acquisition of 11 heavy equipment for drainage improvement and emergency flood mitigation are 12 necessary tools for the Department of Public Works to carry out its mandates and 13 14 responsibilities to ensure proper maintenance of our roadways.
