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**AN ACT TO REPROGRAM AVAILABLE FUNDS FROM THE  
HIGHWAY 2001 BOND CONSTRUCTION FUND AND THE  
HIGHWAY 1985 BOND CONSTRUCTION FUND, AND  
DESIGNATE AND PRIORITIZE CERTAIN CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, AND PURCHASE HEAVY  
EQUIPMENT NEEDED BY DPW FOR FLOOD MITIGATION.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent:** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the projects funded and authorized pursuant to the Highway 2001 Bond Construction Fund, as provided pursuant to §22427, Division 2, 5 GCA, and the Highway 1985 Bond Construction Fund, as provided pursuant to §1504 of 5 GCA, have been completed and that there are remaining funds available for reprogramming for flood mitigation projects throughout the island. There are specific areas in Barrigada, Dededo and Harmon that require immediate action. The projects listed in Section 2 of this Act are areas that the Department of Public Works have been made aware of their conditions and the work necessary to mitigate flooding. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the acquisition of heavy equipment for drainage improvement and emergency flood mitigation are necessary tools for the Department of Public Works to carry out its mandates and responsibilities to ensure proper maintenance of our roadways.

**Section 2. Reprogramming and Appropriation of Available Bond Funds.** (a) The aggregate SUM of ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED TWELVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN DOLLARS and twenty-five one-hundredths (\$1,112,167.25) from available funds in the Highway 2001 Bond Construction Fund (pursuant to §22427, Division 2, 5 GCA), Account number: 71 05 2000 3 0, in the amount of Fourteen Thousand Three Hundred Seventeen Dollars and eighty-three one-hundredths (\$14,317.83), and from available funds in the Highway 1985 Bond Construction Fund (pursuant to §1504 of 5 GCA), Account number: 71 00 0011 3 01, in the amount of One Million Ninety-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars and forty-two one-hundredths (\$1,097,859.42) are hereby REPROGRAMMED and APPROPRIATED for the following projects and purposes listed:

**Section 3.** The actual expenditure of funds reprogrammed and appropriated pursuant to Section 2, *shall* only be made available for the projects approved pursuant to this Act *after* the Department of Public Works and the Department of Administration have certified that the capital projects initially authorized prior to this Act have been completed. *If* additional funding is required for any projects not yet completed, *then*, funding shall be subtracted, starting from the last project prioritized in Section 2 of this Act, and so forth, until the original projects authorized and funded pursuant to the initial purpose of the Bonds are completed.

**Section 4. Reporting Requirement.** The Department of Public Works and the Department of Administration shall submit a status report on all capital projects

1 initially authorized prior to this Act, as provided pursuant to §1504 of 5 GCA and  
2 §22427, Division 2, 5 GCA, as well as the status of capital projects and other  
3 purposes authorized pursuant to this Act, to *I Maga'lahan Guåhan*, and the  
4 *Speaker, I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

5       **Section 5. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or its application to  
6 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such  
7 invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be  
8 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the  
9 provisions of this Act are severable.

10       **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Act shall become immediately effective  
11 upon enactment.
