TO THE AN ACT RELATIVE EXPANDING ON THE REPRESENTATION HAGATNA **RESTORATION & REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY,** TO INCLUDE THE MAYOR OF HAGATNA AND A LEGISLATIVE REPRESENTATIVE, AND FOR OTHER AMENDING **PURPOSES;** THROUGH **§§79301** OF ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER 79, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2013 APR 1 Mar 4: 42 §§79301 of Article 3, Chapter 79, Title 21, Guam Code Section 1. 2 Annotated, relative to the Establishment provisions of the Hagatna Restoration and 3 Redevelopment Authority is hereby amended to read as follows: 4

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"§ 79301. Establishment.

There is within, and a public corporation and autonomous instrumentality 6 government of Guam, the "HAGATÑA **RESTORATION &** the 7 of. REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY." The powers, rights, privileges, functions 8 and duties of the Authority shall be vested in seven (7) nine (9) Commissioners, 9 selected in accordance with the provisions in this Section. Seven (7) The 10 Commissioners shall be appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice and 11 consent of the Guam Legislature, to serve for a term of five (5) years. The eighth 12 and ninth Commissioners shall be selected as follows: one of the 13 Commissioners shall be the Mayor of Hagatna, who shall serve for the 14

duration of his/her term(s); one (1) member shall be appointed by the Speaker
of the Guam Legislature, who shall serve at the pleasure of the Speaker, and
whose appointment shall be effective until the conclusion of the term of the
Guam Legislature in which he/she was appointed.

(a) Before taking office or entering on duty, each Commissioner, as well as
each employee of the Authority, shall take the oath of office required of all officers
and employees of the government of Guam.

8 (b) Any Commissioner, **appointed by the Governor**, may be removed by 9 the Governor for inefficiency, neglect of duty or misconduct in office, after a 10 hearing before the Governor or a hearing officer specially designated by him for 11 the purpose.

(c) A Commissioner shall receive no compensation for his services, but shall
 be entitled to payment of official travel costs and reimbursement of expenses
 actually and necessarily incurred in the discharge of his duties and functions.

(d) The Governor shall designate a Chairman and Vice-Chairman from 15 among the Commissioners. The Commissioners shall constitute the Board of 16 Commissioners of the Authority. The Board may employ an Executive Director of 17 the Authority who shall serve at the pleasure of the Board, technical experts, such 18 other officers, agents and employees, permanent and temporary, as it may deem 19 necessary, and shall determine their qualifications, duties, tenure and 20 compensation. For such legal service as it may require, the Authority may employ 21 or retain its own counsel and legal staff. The Authority may delegate to one (1) or 22 more of its officers, agents or employees, such powers and duties as it may deem 23 proper. The Board shall adopt personnel rules pursuant to 4 GCA § 4105 and § 24 4106. 25

(e) Four (4) Five (5) Commissioners shall constitute a quorum of the Board
 of Commissioners of the Authority for the purpose of conducting the business of

the Authority and exercising its powers, and for all other purposes. A vote of the
majority of Commissioners present at any meeting of the Board shall prevail.

(f) Non-voting ex-officio members shall include representatives from the
Department of Parks and Recreation, the Richard F. Taitano Micronesian Area
Research Center, the Chamorro Language Commission, the Department of Land
Management, Department of Public Works, Guam Environmental Protection
Agency, and the Guam Preservation Trust. These members shall provide technical
assistance to insure accuracy in the development of the Plan."

9 Section 2. Effective Date.

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The provisions contained herein shall be effective immediately upon
enactment of this Act.

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
