AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 14 OF CHAPTER XII, OF PUBLIC LAW 31-233, RELATIVE TO THE STIPENDS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 14 of Chapter XII of Public Law 31-233 hereby amended to read:

"Section 14. Board and Commission Meeting Stipends. Any compensation or stipend owed to a Board or Commission member for attending a regular or special meeting in Fiscal Year 2013 shall be paid from the budget of the department or agency responsible for the administrative support and operations of such Boards or Commissions. *Except* for the Civil Service Commission, any Boar—d member who has served on a Board continuously for ten (10) years or more may receive a stipend totaling no more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) per month for meetings attended; however, Board and Commission members may elect to not receive said compensation, I Maga'låhen Guåhan may by Executive Order, waive the payment of meeting stipends owed to any Board or Commission member."
