AN **ACT** TO **EXTENDING** RELATIVE THE APPLICABILITY OF THE WAIVER OF **DRIVER'S** LICENSE FEES FOR VETERANS TO INCLUDE ALL **CLASSES** AND **ENDORSEMENTS:** THROUGH AMENDING §3102.1 OF CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 1, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §3102.1 of Chapter 3, Article 1, Title 16, Guam Code 2 Annotated, pertaining to Drivers License Fees Waived for Veterans, is hereby 3 amended to read as follows: 4
- 5 "§ 3102.1. Waiver of Fees for Veterans.
- The fee for the issuance of a motor vehicle driver's license, to include all 6 classes and endorsements, an operator's, chauffeur's, or motorcycle license is 7 8 waived for Veterans of the United States Armed Forces. Veterans include persons who served in the Guam Combat Patrol, the United States Navy Insular Forces, 9 10 Guam Militia or Civilian Scouts, Philippines Scouts and the United States Armed Services.
 - Any person listed above and whose character of military service was honorable as verified by the applicant's Report of Transfer or Discharge (DD Form 214), or Military Identification Card Department of Defense Form 2 (Retired), or other accepted forms used to verify membership in the organization listed and certified by the government of Guam Office of Veterans Affairs (OVA) may apply to the License Division of the Department of Revenue and Taxation for a Driver's

- 1 License. Certification by the OVA will be based only upon records they have
- 2 available. When requested by the OVA, the Department of Revenue and Taxation
- 3 shall provide a listing of Veterans granted fee waivers."
- 4 Section 2. Effective Date.
- 5 The provisions contained herein shall be effective upon enactment of
- 6 this Act.
