**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF THREE  
MILLION DOLLARS (\$3,000,000) FROM SECTION 30  
TAX REVENUES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF  
EDUCATION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF  
PROVISIONS OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 31-29.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*

finds that it is in the best interest of the Territory that funds from the advance estimate of the 2014 Section 30 taxes owed to Guam by the Office of Insular Affairs, United States Department of the Interior be used to support the priorities of education.

**Section 2.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) is appropriated from the Section 30 tax revenues to the Guam Department of Education (GDOE). These funds *shall*

1 be used to implement the authorizations contained in Guam Public Law No.  
2 31-29 relative to the implementing Public-Private Partnerships to address the  
3 management of the maintenance operation, and repair of GDOE facilities in  
4 the Guam public school system.

5 **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Law or its application  
6 to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such  
7 invalidity *shall* not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which  
8 can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this  
9 end the provisions of this Law are severable.
