AN ACT TO AMEND §3102 OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO
DRIVER'S LICENSE RENEWALS.

F ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 3 Guam law recently allowed drivers to renew their operator licenses for a period of 4 either three (3) or five (5) years. In order to even further alleviate delays and provide improve service for the customers at the Department of Revenue and Taxation Motor 5

6 Vehicle Division, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to amend §3102 of Chapter 7

3, Title 16 Guam Code Annotated relative to the renewal of driver's licenses.

**Section 2.** §3102 of Chapter 3, Title 16 Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended to read:

"§3102. Same: Fees. The following fee schedule in items (a) through (h) is valid for a three (3) year period. The applicant may elect for a license, notwithstanding §3101(m), Chapter 3, Title 16 GCA, which shall be valid for a five (5) six (6) year period, provided that, the fee for such a license shall be Forty-five Dollars (\$45.00) fifty dollars (\$50.00). The fee for the issuance of a motor vehicle driver's license is as follows:

8	not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect		
9	without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
10	Law are severable.
