**AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5102(d) OF TITLE 7 OF THE
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE POWER OF
THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL TO ADOPT PAY SCHEDULES
AND PLANS AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SALARY
AND BENEFIT INCREASES FOR NON-LAW
ENFORCEMENT EMPLOYEES OF THE JUDICIARY**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Amendment of § 5102 of Chapter 5, Title 7 Guam Code Annotated. Section 5102 (d) of Chapter 5, Title 7 GCA is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

“(d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, To adopt a unified a pay plan and pay schedules for the classified and unclassified employees of the Judicial Branch consistent with the Hay Study and Unified Pay Schedule adopted in 1991, as amended government-wide plan pursuant to Section 13 of Public Law 29-52 and Executive Order 2006-21 or the transmittal of January 15, 2014 to I Liheslaturan entitled the Government of Guam Competitive Wage Act of 2014, subject to appropriations as provided by Liheslaturan Guåhan;”

Section 2. Appropriation to the Unified Judiciary. The sum of Five Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$510,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Unified Judiciary for Fiscal Year 2014 salary and benefits increases for classified and unclassified non-law enforcement employees consistent with compensation policies adopted pursuant to 7 GCA § 5102(d), as amended.

1 **Section 3.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, appropriations made
2 to the Unified Judiciary in Chapter XI of Public Law 32-068 shall be used for
3 salary and benefit increases pursuant to subsection (b) of Chapter XI of Public Law
4 32-068.
