AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13 TO CHAPTER X OF PUBLIC LAW 32-068 (GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 2014) MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE TOURIST ATTRACTION FUND (TAF) TO GVB FOR THE *AMOT TAOTAO TANO* FARM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that as a government, that as a government, we must do our part in an effort to preserve and protect our unique language, culture, stories, identity, and resources; instill a confidence and pride in our unique identity and our island community; inspire a deep love for our water, land, and people; and promote sustainable and healthy ways of living.

8 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that revenue estimates for the Tourist 9 Attraction Fund (TAF) for Fiscal Year 2014 are tracking at Thirty Million One 10 Hundred Sixty-Seven Thousand Three Dollars (\$30,167,003), of which Twenty-11 Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$28,500,000) is appropriated.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the TAF revenues for Fiscal Year
 2014 are projected to exceed appropriations by One Million Six Hundred Sixty Seven Thousand Three Dollars (\$1,667,003) and is available for appropriation.

Section 2. Section 13 of Chapter X (Guam Visitors Bureau) of Public Law
 32-068 is amended to read:

Section 13. Appropriation to GVB for the Amot TaoTao Tano Farm. 3 $\mathbf{4}$ The sum of Twenty Five Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) (\$25,000) is 5 appropriated from the TAF to the GVB for Fiscal Year 2014 operations of 6 the Amot Taotao Tano Farm for the purpose of the preservation of traditional Chamorro healing arts. Notwithstanding the general 7 8 provisions of § 30107.1, of Chapter 30, Title 11 GCA and this Act, this 9 appropriation *shall* continue to be available until expended. 10 Effective Date. The provisions contained herein shall take Section 3.

Section 3. Effective Date. The provisions contained herein shall take
effect immediately upon the enactment of this Act.
