MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE TOURIST
ATTRACTION FUND (TAF) TO THE GUAM HUMANITIES
COUNCIL**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that as a government, that as a government, we must do our part in an effort to preserve and protect our unique language, culture, stories, identity, and resources; instill a confidence and pride in our unique identity and our island community; inspire a deep love for our water, land, and people; and promote sustainable and healthy ways of living.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that revenue estimates for the Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF) for Fiscal Year 2014 are tracking at Thirty Million One Hundred Sixty-Seven Thousand Three Dollars (**\$30,167,003**), of which Twenty-Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (**\$28,500,000**) is appropriated.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the TAF revenues for Fiscal Year 2014 are projected to exceed appropriations by One Million Six Hundred Sixty-Seven Thousand Three Dollars (**\$1,667,003**) and is available for appropriation.

1 **Section 2. A New Section 24 of Chapter X (Guam Visitors Bureau) of**
2 **Public Law 32-068 is added to read:**

3 **Section 24. Appropriation to Guam Humanities Council.** The
4 sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (**\$20,000**) is hereby appropriated from the
5 Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF) to Guam Council on Arts and Humanities for
6 the purposes of its operations. Notwithstanding the general provisions
7 of § 30107.1, of Chapter 30, Title 11 GCA and this Act, this
8 appropriation *shall* continue to be available until expended.

9 **Section 3. Effective Date.** The provisions contained herein shall take
10 effect immediately upon the enactment of this Act.
