AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$600,000 FOR A GYMNASIUM AND SPORTS CLASSROOMS IN NORTHERN GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) is appropriated from the revenues of the Limited 3 4 Gaming authorized By Section 5201, Article 1 Chapter 5, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, 5 to the Guam Economic Development Authority for the Guam Football Association for 6 the development of gymnasium and classrooms in sports facilities in the northern part 7 of the island. 8 Funding shall only be disbursed as a matching grant of private funds secured by 9 the Guam Football Association pursuant to Chapter 77, Article 3 Title 12 GCA. 10 The Guam Football Association shall submit to the Guam Economic Development 11 Authority evidence of matching grant funds secured prior to the certification of funds 12 for disbursement, project plan(s) and subsequent invoices for project(s) funded by said 13 appropriation.
