AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 10, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 2 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED TO ADD NEW A **SUBSECTION** 3218(a)(25) REOUIRE ABORTION TO PROVIDERS **GESTATIONAL** INCLUDE AGE IN≊ TO **ABORTION REPORTS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* inds that the Government of Guam has a public health interest in knowing the gestational age of unborn children terminated by abortion on Guam. The purpose of this act (the "Act"), therefore, is to add the gestational age of the unborn child terminated by the abortion to the information that abortion providers must include in the abortion reports which they presently submit to the Guam Memorial Hospital Medical Records Section pursuant to 10 G.C.A. §3218.

9 Section 2. A New Subsection 3218(a)(25). Title 10, Chapter 3, Article 2,
10 Section 3218, Subsections (a)(23) through (a)(25) of the Guam Code
11 Annotated are amended to read as follows:

- 12 "(23) Signature of attending physician; **and**
- 13 (24) Certification provided for in this section; and

1(25) Gestational age, as measured in weeks, of the unborn child2terminated by the abortion."

Section 3. Severability. Any provision of this Act held to be invalid *or* unenforceable by its terms or as applied to any persons or circumstance, *shall* be construed so as to give it the maximum effect permitted by law unless such holding shall be one of utter invalidity or unenforceability, in which event, such provision *shall* be deemed severable herefrom and *shall* not affect the remainder hereof *or* the application of such provision to the other persons *not* similarly situated *or* to other dissimilar circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act *shall* take effect thirty (30) days after enactment.
