

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 3226 (h) (2) of Title 9, Division 1, Chapter 3 of the Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations (GAR) is amended as follows:

"(2) Unless a solid roof covers the entire facility, [T]he premises of a CQF shall be surrounded by a perimeter fence no less than eight feet in height and topped with barbed wire tilted inward. Fencing shall be composed of concrete, solid metal, or wire. All wire shall be of a mesh size of two (2) inches by two (2) inches or less and of no less than nine (9) gauge. "

Section 2. Any commercial quarantine facility with a perimeter wire fence with mesh size greater than two (2) inches by two (2) inches shall have a grace period of 6 months from the enactment of this Act to comply with the fencing requirement in Section 1.
