## AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTIONS (a) AND (d) OF TITLE 17 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; TO AMEND SUBSECTION (a) OF §5008.2 OF TITLE 5 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROCUREMENT OF SOLAR ENERGY FOR GDOE SCHOOLS.

### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. Subsection (a) of § 7116 of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated is
hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(a) The Guam Department of Education (GDOE) may enter into one or more power purchase agreements to purchase solar energy from qualified provider(s) which 5 6 will be in the best financial interests of the government of Guam for a period of up to and not exceeding twenty-five (25) years. Such qualified PPA provider(s) shall be 7 8 selected by a Multi-Step Bid conducted by GSA GDOE, in accordance with the 9 procurement law and regulations of Guam. The qualified PPA provider(s) will be responsible for providing a PPA to cover no more than eighty percent (80%) of the 10 jumet jumet school's power needs, all GDOE owned schools, GDOE administrative, and GDOE 12 ancillary buildings. For schools occupied under a lease agreement as of the enactment 13 of this Section, GDOE may amend its lease agreements or otherwise directly enter 14 into a PPA with a lessor for the purchase of solar power produced with renewable 15 energy directly from the lessor and without application of the procurement law."

## 1 Section 2. Subsection (d) of §7116 of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated is 2 hereby amended to read as follows:

eby amended to read as follows: "(d) GDOE and GSA shall seek technical consultation from the Guam Power

Authority in implementing this Section, and the Guam Power Authority shall provide 4 the technical consultation upon request at no cost to GDOE and GSA. GDOE and 5 GSA may further seek technical consultation from the Guam Energy Office, the 6 Department of Public Works, the Guam Renewable Energy Association, and/or a third 7 party renewable energy consultant in implementing this Section, and the consultation 8 shall be at no cost to GDOE and GSA; any costs associated with a third party 9 10consultant will be passed through in total to the qualified PPA provider(s) equally and in full who is awarded the Multi-Step Bid." 11

# 12 Section 3. Subsection (a) of §5008.2 of Title 5 Guam Code Annotated is 13 hereby amended to read as follows:

- 14 "(a) In procuring services as cited in § 7120 of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated,
- 15 GSA the Guam Department of Education shall, subject to the provisions of Title 5,
- 16 Chapter 5, GCA, grant a preference to a local business."
