II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 3:00 PM.

Senator Frank B. Aguon Jr.

Good Afternoon Ladies & Gentlemen before we begin this public hearing & confirmation hearing, I would like to please remind everyone that your phones are turned off or placed in vibrate mode. This confirmation hearing is sponsored by the Committee on Guam US Military Buildup, Infrastructure, and Transportation is hereby convened. We do have 2 items on the agenda and that is the appointment by the Governor of Guam of Mr. Gurvindor S. Sobti as a member of the Antonio B. WonPat International Airport Authority Board of Directors for a length of 3 years and the second item on the agenda is also an appointment by the Governor of Guam for Mr. Ricardo C. Duenas also as a member Antonio B. WonPat International Airport Authority Board of Directors for the similar time frame of 3 years.

Compliance of the open government law, the information of this confirmation hearing was disseminated initially on May 11 and subsequent 2nd notice was distributed. I'm sorry, I take that back the initial notification was disseminated on May 8 and the 2nd notice confirmation out to the community and stakeholders was disseminated on May 11. Like I mentioned a little earlier we have two items on the agenda. I will like to thank my colleagues Senator Wil Castro for joining us this afternoon at this confirmation hearing and we will proceed with the individuals and their appointments.

At this time, I'd like to invite, actually he is already in the panel, Mr. Ric Duenas for a similar appointment for a three-year term to the Antonio B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Board of Directors. We have the following individuals that signed up. Mr. Charles Ada II, Karl Pangelinan I know you provided testimony initially and Mrs. Kathy Sgro, so anyone who would like to provide oral testimony you are invited up to the front to be able to provide your testimony. We will start off with Mrs. Sgro.

Mrs. Kathy Sgro

Thank you Mr. Chairman. Chairman Ric Duenas came on board in April 2016 and he hit the ground running, he was automatically appointed chairman of the board and his background doesn't in fact help and strengthen the background of our board. He has been very attentive in the details of the financial state of the airport and he oversees of course finance operations and the administration committees and it's been a pleasure being the vice chairman under him and I am very confident that he will continue to lead our board in his capacity as chairman and I am here to testify in his favor and I ask for your approval. Thank you.

Thank you very much Mr. Ada for testimonies this afternoon. Mr. Pangelinan.

Mr. Karl Pangelinan

Thank you again Mr. Chairman. I will keep this brief, I said a few words already about Ric but I'll go ahead and continue. I know the jolly and the outgoing side of Mr Duenas, but in my two full years at GEDA, I was just exposed to a very professional task master to the point in terms of running an actual board meeting. I am very envious of Mr. Ada over there, who is very fortunate to have the leadership of Mr. Duenas heading up the Board of Directors. Enough can't be said about his knowledge in finance and accounting and in terms of looking and examining the numbers and where things are at. There is a lot of number that run through the airport and there's not a better person to be on top overseeing all of those, so again I ask the committee as well as the entire body to act swiftly on the reappointment of Mr. Duenas.

Thank you very much Mr. Pangelinan. You're here for moral support, okay. Mr. Duenas.

Mr. Ricardo Duenas

Thank you very much Chairman Aguon. As I said my name is Ricardo C. Duenas and I am currently that Chairman for the Guam International Airport Authority I have submitted written testimony, but I always prefer to speak from the heart in situations like this just to give you an idea of what my feelings are. First of all, I'd like to thank Governor Calvo for considering me again to serve on this board; it's been a pleasure and an honor.

Mr. Ricardo Duenas

Over the past year I've had the pleasure and the honor to serve in this board and to get to know a lot of different people not just on the board, but also the management team at the airport and the rank and file of the airport and for the past thirteen months, I've become very impressed with the operations at the airport. The individuals there that work day in and day out working to ensure the safety and comfort not just for our passengers and residents, but also all of the travelers in and out of Guam. The airport serves as the economic engine for our island, with our reliance on tourism and the military. The airport serves a crucial role in tourism, bringing all of our tourist in and out, and as many people have said, we are the first contact and first impression for all of our travelers coming in.

During the past year I've seen all the projects that are undergoing and under consideration and I am impressed and sometimes overwhelmed at the amount of work that goes on at the airport. Ultimately the goal is to modernize our airport so that we are a leader in the region and today we are a leader in the region as far as airports go. As Mr. Ada has mentioned, over the last four years we have been awarded a clean audit by the Public Auditor in examining our books. This past year, we were awarded, for the first time in the region, a perfect score by the FAA upon our annual inspection for certification. It's the first this airport, or any airport in the region including Hawaii a much larger airport, was awarded a perfect score. That's really attributed to the dedication of management and the rank in file staff. That's why I am here and I'm honored to be asked to serve, because I've seen the hard work done and I want to be a part of that. I want to be able to help modernize our airport to make sure it's a safe and comfortable environment.

Senator Lee as far as some of the questions you brought up regarding the food court as Director Sobti has mentioned, there will be a massive food concession that will be going out in a short time. When that goes out certainly that will be the time for us to take a look and see when we go through the bidding process and lay out some of the things that we want to see in that new food concession to include more local options, something that is more representative of our culture, maybe more healthy choices. We want our people to have a selection, not just different Asian foods and local foods, but also healthy foods.

As far as the arts, part of the budget for the third and fourth quarter under law is that one percent of our cost will go towards our cultural aspect, certainly we will be looking for, as we get further into that project, ways how we can showcase our local culture throughout the airport so our visitors have a sense when they are coming in and when they are leaving that they are actually in an island airport, a paradise airport. Those are some of the things that we are looking at. And as I mentioned, there are so many projects that are undergoing right now with parking structures and with the ARFF Facility. There's a lot of moving parts and I hope that if you are to extend my nomination and approve me to serve on the board those are things that I would like to work on in the next three years. Thank you.

Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr

Thank you very much Mr. Duenas. You are absolutely right; speaking of the heart certainly is reflective of your knowledge and expertise with regards to the airport authority. What's interesting is what Mrs. Sgro mentioned that you've only been there about a year and since then you've hit the ground running, and it's reflective in your comments and one thing that I really appreciate is not only did the statements that you made in regards to modernizing the airport facility, recognizing that the airport is the economic engine for our island community and also the clean audit assessment with a perfect score with the FAA, those are all tremendous accomplishments, but one thing that really rings in my mind is that you recognize management and staff and the team members over at the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, because they are certainly the backbone of that organization and I thank you for that because it's truly reflective of how you view the airport, running the airport from the Board of Directors perspective and ensuring that it's a familiar environment and that it's a team that is actually projecting the airport facility and the island community moving forward, so I certainly have an appreciation for that I look forward to voting on your nomination sometime next week if we are able to get the committee report out. Senators any comments. Senator Castro.

Dispensa [excuse me] Mr. Chairman, chumachalik yu guini sa lache talo' bidahu [I am laughing here because again, I did something wrong]. Sa ti sinu tiempottai gi [It's just like back in the old days] Father Duenas hu tatiyi si [I would follow] Mr. Pangelinan and I had no idea that we were going in subsequent fashion, as a matter of fact he gave a shot gun testimony and so I followed suit, and even as a quarterback, Mr. Pangelinan when you're call was off I followed suit, forgive me, I'm sorry Mr. Duenas for speaking out of term, but I will add that my confidence rest in that your resume evidence is you're a member of the Knights of Columbus and so I'm assured, at least I like to think, that at the end of the day you answer to a higher moral authority so thank you again.

Thank you Senator Castro. Senator Lee.

Thank you Mr. Chair and thank you so much Mr. Duenas for anticipating some of my questions. With regards to your testimony, I just wanted to first thank you for your continued service. I know that you served on the GEDA Board and you had a lot of success over there so we're glad that you're able to continue your service and Thank you so much for accepting the Governor's appointment to this post and we look forward to confirming you.

You mentioned safety, safety was the first thing that you alluded to, so I wanted to ask what your thoughts are about any safety challenges that we have at the airport and how the Board under your leadership and with the hard work of Mr. Ada and his team are working to address any of the safety challenges.

Mr. Ricardo Duenas

Well first of all, you have to understand that at the airport obviously safety is mission one. We are operating the situation where the lives of thousands of people each day are in our hands, whether it's from the flight coming in, the processing of our visitors, through clearances, individuals coming to pick up passengers once they get off the plane, the securing of our boarders within the airport to ensure that everything is safe. We place a lot of emphasis on two particular entities, our Airport Police and Fire and Rescue. We hold them to high standards, we make sure they are adequately trained and given the resources to successfully carry out their mission within the airport. As far as in the airport terminal itself, we make sure that our facilities are within the mandates of the Transportation Safety Administration as well as the FAA and Customs Border Patrol, making sure our passengers are secured and in a sterile environment. We make sure that we anticipate any contingency and have plans and back of plans to address those situations. So when you say what are doing as far as ensuring safety, the safety concern permeates our operation throughout our operation, from the police to the fire department, to safety at the gates, to making sure our passengers know where to go, how to get there and how to get there safe and in a reasonable manner. It's really throughout the whole organization and I hope that answers your question.

Thank you very much Senator Lee. Thank you again Mr. Pangelinan, Mr. Sobti, Mr. Duenas, Mr. Ada and Mrs. Sgro and to all of your supporters in the back of the Public Hearing room. Thank you again for extending yourselves to the community and I look forward to voting at your nomination next week. This concludes the Confirmation Hearing on the Appointment of Mr. Sobti and Mr. Duenas to the Board of Directors of the Airport and for the information of the public, the committee will continue to received written testimony up until the close of business on Wednesday the 17th of May. Upon that the committee will work on closing the Committee Report so that we can request from our colleagues to place these two appointments on the agenda for session next week.
